On 1/13/19 at 1435 hrs. I was dispatched to 2 in reference to a possible overdose/suicide attempt. Dispatch advised that the male took an unknown amount of pills earlier in the morning in an apparent attempt to harm himself. Dispatch advised that the roommate was the caller. The roommate was later identified as 3. The male victim was later identified as 4.

Upon arrival I met with both males. 5 was lying on the bed in his bedroom and he was conscious, alert and oriented. 6 was cooperative and he admitted he took a bottle of medication because he wanted to kill himself. 7 had the empty bottle on an end table next to his bed. 8 stated he also took a small amount of pills from another bottle that was also on the end table. The medication was identified as Meloxicam 15mg and Duloxetine HCL DR 30mg (generic for Cymbalta). The Duloxetine HCL DR 30mg is prescribed by Dr. 9 and it was filled with 60 tablets on 11/13/18. The Meloxicam 15mg is stored in a medication bottle with a handwritten label and it is unknown when it was filled and which doctor prescribed the medication. It was later learned that the Meloxicam is prescribed for congestion and Duloxetine is prescribed for arthritis.

10 stated the bottle of Duloxetine had approximately 50 tablets and the bottle of Meloxicam had approximately 5-7 tablets. 11 stated he ingested all of the tablets from each bottle at approximately 0900 hrs. this morning in an effort to kill himself. 12 stated he has been having a hard time dealing with events that have transpired in his life. 13 stated his parents have passed away and his brother passed away when he overdosed on pills approximately 2 years ago. 14 stated he suffers from depression and he has been treated at St. Barnabas Behavioral Health Center in the past. 15 stated he wished to get help his depression. 16 even added that he would like to go to Kimball Medical Center because he is familiar with the Crisis Unit there.

17 corroborated 18 account of this incident. He stated 19 told him earlier this morning that he took too many pills, however, 20 didn't tell him that it was an attempt to kill himself. 21 stated that he believed he took one too many pills of his prescribed medication on accident. 22 stated he knows 23 has been dealing with depression issues. 24 stated he called after talking with 25 and he realized that 26 overdosed on purpose.

vomiting and unable to feel her lower extremities. Upon arrival I was met by the caller who identified himself as 1 [REDACTED] advised me the victim was his daughter and is identified as 2 [REDACTED] (victim). Upon entry, the victim was observed lying on her bed in the rear bedroom, complaining of severe pain in her stomach and hip area. The victim stated she could not feel anything below her knees could not stand up. The victim's speech was slow and slurred and communicating with her was difficult. The victim stated she injected heroin into her left arm earlier in the day and could not provide me with any further information.

3 [REDACTED] stated at approximately 0630 hours, he heard the victim inside her bedroom complaining of pain. 4 [REDACTED] stated the bedroom door was locked and the victim could not get to the door. 5 [REDACTED] stated he used the key to get into the bedroom and observed the victim lying on the ground, with vomit on her, and a heroin needle lying on the ground next to her. 6 [REDACTED] further stated the wax paper fold containing heroin had 7 [REDACTED] on it. 8 [REDACTED] stated he picked the victim up and put her in the shower to clean her off and then put her back into bed, hoping the effects of the heroin would wear off. 9 [REDACTED] stated the victim started to feel better throughout the day until approximately 1730 hours, when she started to experience severe stomach and hip pain and he contacted police. When I asked where the heroin and needle was, he stated it was disposed of and no longer in the residence.

10 [REDACTED] stated he resides in Georgia and the victim just recently got out of a rehab facility in Florida for heroin use. 11 [REDACTED] stated he drove the victim to New Jersey because she has an upcoming court date and they are staying at their friends house at [REDACTED] until the court date. Narcan was not deployed and the victim was transported to Community Medical Center for further evaluation. OD Mapping and OD form was completed and there will be no further action by this officer.
