IGINAL REPORT Reported By: HAYES, THOMAS M. 1/05/19

On the above date and time, Sgt. Grace, PFC. Nase and this officer responded to a 911 call for an overdose at [REDACTED]. Upon arrival, these officers met the caller (identified as [REDACTED] who stated [REDACTED] took heroine and collapsed. These officers observed [REDACTED] on the ground unconscious and experiencing agonal breathing. The first dose of Naloxone (lot 171395) was delivered at 2:06. The first dose was not immediately effective and the second dose (lot 180454) was given at 2:08, which was effective. These officers recovered 2 used intravenous syringes and two wax folds stamped with Chase and the Chase Bank symbol on them. The wax folds contained residual powder.

The first aid squad arrived on scene and [REDACTED] was transported to Ocean Medical Center by the first aid squad for further evaluation. All evidence was processed and placed into the evidence drop and marked for destruction.
