ON THE ABOVE DATE AND TIME I RESPONDED TO [REDACTED] HALLIARD AVENUE IN REFERENCE TO A REPORT OF A 23 YEAR OLD MALE UNCONSCIOUS AND NOT BREATHING. PTL. BRUNO AND MYSELF ARRIVED ON SCENE. UPON MY ARRIVAL I WAS MET BY THE LISTED COMPLAINANT, [REDACTED] WHO DIRECTED ME UPSTAIRS TO THE VICTIM'S ROOM. WHILE UPSTAIRS, I OBSERVED THE LISTED VICTIM, [REDACTED], ON THE FLOOR UNCONSCIOUS BUT WAS BREATHING. [REDACTED] STATED THAT [REDACTED] POSSIBLY TOOK HEROIN, BUT WAS NOT EXACTLY SURE. I ADMINISTERED ONE DOSE OF NARCAN AND THEN ADMINISTERED OXYGEN TO [REDACTED] SHORTLY AFTER BEACHWOOD FIRST AID ARRIVED ON SCENE. APPROXIMATELY 5 MINUTES AFTER ADMINISTERING THE NARCAN [REDACTED] BEGAN TO PERIODICALLY REGAIN CONSCIOUSNESS. AFTER ABOUT 7 MINUTES [REDACTED] REGAINED CONSCIOUSNESS AND WAS ABLE TO SIT UP ONTO HIS BED. [REDACTED] STATED THAT HE INJECTED THREE BAGS OF HEROIN, BUT DID NOT RECALL WHERE HE DISPOSED OF THE NEEDLE OR BAGS. NO EVIDENCE WAS RECOVERED FROM THE SCENE. [REDACTED] WAS EVENTUALLY TRANSPORTED TO COMMUNITY MEDICAL CENTER BY BEACHWOOD FIRST AID.

AFTER SPEAKING WITH [REDACTED] SHE STATED THAT SHE HEARD [REDACTED] FALL IN HIS ROOM AND KNOCKED TO MAKE SURE HE WAS OKAY. AFTER NOT GETTING A RESPONSE SHE OPENED THE DOOR TO HIS ROOM TO FIND HIM ON THE FLOOR UNCONSCIOUS AND WAS NOT BREATHING.

LT MELILLO AND DSGT ALTMAN WERE CONTACTED AND BRIEFED ON THE INCIDENT. I ARRIVED AT COMMUNITY MEDICAL CENTER TO REPLENISH THE NARCAN THAT WAS DELIVERED TO [REDACTED] THEN RESUMED PATROL SHORTLY AFTER.

ON THE ABOVE DATE AND TIME, THIS OFFICER, ALONG WITH LT MELILLO, AND PTL ALLEN, RESPONDED TO [REDACTED] FOREPEAK AVENUE FOR AN OVERDOSE. WHILE ENROUTE, OCEAN COUNTY RADIO ROOM ADVISED THAT A FAMILY MEMBER ADMINISTERED NARCAN TO THE PATIENT. UPON ARRIVAL I WAS DIRECTED TO THE PATIENT, (IDENTIFIED AS [REDACTED] BY [REDACTED] (MOTHER OF PATIENT)). [REDACTED] SAID [REDACTED] WAS OUTSIDE ON THE BACK DECK SMOKING A CIGARETTE. WHEN I WALKED UP TO [REDACTED] I ASKED HIM WHAT WAS GOING ON. [REDACTED] SAID HE WASN'T FEELING WELL AND HE FELL ASLEEP IN HIS ROOM. [REDACTED] SAID HE WOKE UP TO HIS PARENTS YELLING AT HIM. I OBSERVED [REDACTED] PUPILS WERE CONSTRICTED AND HE WAS LOSING HIS BALANCE STANDING UP. WHEN I SPOKE TO [REDACTED] SHE SAID SHE WAS MAKING DINNER AND WHEN SHE WENT INTO [REDACTED] ROOM TO GET HIM SHE NOTICED HE WAS SLEEPING. [REDACTED] SAID SHE TRIED TO SHOUT AND SHAKE [REDACTED] BUT HE STILL WOULDN'T WAKE. HER HUSBAND, IDENTIFIED AS [REDACTED] TRIED TO RUB [REDACTED] STERNUM AND THAT DIDN'T WORK. [REDACTED] SAID HE WENT INTO THE BATHROOM AND GOT A NALOXONE SPRAY AND USED THAT ON [REDACTED] WHICH WORKED. [REDACTED] SAID HE LOOKED AROUND IN THE ROOM AFTER [REDACTED] WOKE UP AND HE FOUND A STRAW WITH WHITE RESIDUE ON IT. [REDACTED] WAS THEN TRANSPORTED TO COMMUNITY MEDICAL CENTER WITHOUT INCIDENT.

ON THE ABOVE DATE AND TIME, THIS OFFICER ALONG WITH LT. MELILLO RESPONDED TO [REDACTED] BEACHWOOD BLVD. FOR AN UNCONSCIOUS MALE IN THE BACK YARD. UPON ARRIVAL I MET CHIEF R. HULL FROM THE FIRE COMPANY. HE SAID HE WAS FLAGGED DOWN BY A FEMALE THAT HER BROTHER WAS UNCONSCIOUS IN THE BACK YARD ON A BENCH. CHIEF HULL SAID HE TRIED MULTIPLE ATTEMPTS TO WAKE THE PATIENT, (IDENTIFIED AS [REDACTED]) BUT WAS UNSUCCESSFUL. I THEN SET UP AND DEPLOYED NARCAN ON [REDACTED] AND HE WOKE UP WITHIN 10 SECONDS. HE TRIED TO SIT UP IN THE CHAIR BUT WAS UNABLE TO MAINTAIN HIS BALANCE. BEACHWOOD FIRST-AID SQUAD ARRIVED AND TRANSPORTED [REDACTED] TO COMMUNITY MEDICAL CENTER WITHOUT INCIDENT. [REDACTED] OF THE FIRST-AID SQUAD REPLENISHED MY NALOXONE (SEE ATTACHED FORM). A NALOXONE ADMINISTRATION REPORTING FORM WAS ALSO FILLED OUT AND FAXED, (SEE ATTACHED).
