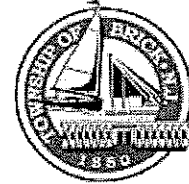

On 02/03/2019 at approximately 1933 hours, Sgt. Matthews #210, Ptl. Chadwick #281, Ptl. Pacyna #287, and I responded to [redacted] reference to an overdose.

Upon arrival to the scene, I observed a male subject, later identified as [redacted] performing CPR on a female subject, later identified as [redacted]. I observed [redacted] unconscious and breathing in an aspirated manner. Due to [redacted] breathing, [redacted] was advised to cease CPR. [redacted] advised [redacted] has a history of opiate addiction and believed that she may have ingested heroin. He stated she went to the bathroom for a short period of time and when she exited she collapsed and believed she may have hit her head on the wall. He stated she did not appear to be breathing and begun CPR.

[redacted] was unconscious, bluish in color, breathing in an aspirated manner, and her pupils were pin-pointed. Due to statements made by [redacted] and my observations of [redacted] I believed her to be suffering from an opiate based overdose and administered one dose of 4mg Naloxone, commonly referred to as Narcan. Life saving measures were performed and continued until [redacted] regained consciousness.

Brick Township Police EMS and MONOC later arrived on scene.

Upon regaining consciousness, [redacted] advised she had consumed several alcoholic beverages, Four Loko's and Fireball shots. In addition, she stated she had injected one wax fold of heroin. She stated after injecting the heroin, she discarded the syringe and fold down the toilet drain. She was asked if the wax fold had any indicators on it and she stated it was clear.

[redacted] was ultimately transported to Ocean Medical Center by Brick Township Police EMS to receive further treatment. While at the hospital, [redacted] was provided with a Blue Hart Magnet and advised of treatment resources.

Naloxone administration form was completed and faxed to the NJ ROIC. Naloxone replenishment form was also completed.

On call Detective, Detective Sgt. Petrola #201, was contacted and advised of the incident.

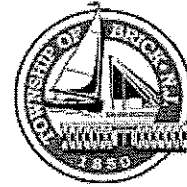

On 02/17/2019 at 0331 hours, Sgt. Dierking #204, Ptl. Hentges #288, and I (Ptl. Oliverio #286) responded to [redacted] in reference to a disorderly person complaint. Dispatch advised the caller stated their twenty-seven (27) year old son was out of control and was possibly under the influence of a controlled dangerous substance (CDS).

Upon arrival we located the suspect, (later identified as [redacted]), laying on the floor of the back bedroom of the residence. [redacted] was on his side, spinning in circles and hitting his head against the floor. I observed blood coming from [redacted] nose and mouth. [redacted] was speaking incoherently and his pupils were dilated.

In an attempt to prevent [redacted] from causing further harm to himself, he was placed in protective custody. Brick EMS and MONOC arrived on scene to treat [redacted] injuries and transport him to Ocean Medical Center (OMC) for further treatment.

Upon arrival at OMC, [redacted] was placed in to four point restraints for his safety and sedated by hospital staff.

Due to [redacted] elevated mental status, we were unable to determine what substance he was under influence of. We were also unable to locate any evidence of CDS use.

Due to the nature of the incident, Det. Puccio #259 of the Brick Township Drug Enforcement Unit was notified.

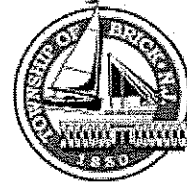

On 2/17/19 at 0926 hours I responded to [redacted] to an overdose. The caller, [redacted], stated her 30yr old son, [redacted] was unconscious with agonal breathing from a possible heroin overdose.

Upon arrival I was met by [redacted] girlfriend, [redacted] who advised me [redacted] was starting to wake up. [redacted] then escorted to me to a bedroom on the first floor where I observed [redacted] on the floor leaning over [redacted] was semi-conscious and having trouble keeping his eyes open. I observed an uncapped syringe laying on the bed and several empty wax folds, along with a metal spoon with burnt residue, and a cotton swap on the night stand next to the bed. The wax folds were labeled with a blue stamp of a skull with two crossing hand guns and a sword. Sgt Kelly #241, Ptl. Heschle #135 and Brick EMS arrived on scene a short time later.

While EMS evaluated [redacted] I spoke with [redacted] who stated she awoke from a nap and found [redacted] unconscious laying on the bed with a needle in his arm. [redacted] stated [redacted] lips were blue and he was unresponsive. [redacted] alerted [redacted] mother [redacted] who in turn called 911. [redacted] was ultimately transported to Ocean Medical Center for further evaluation. I collected all CDS and paraphernalia and responded to OMC to speak with [redacted] stated he used two wax folds, intravenously, prior to being found unconscious. [redacted] advised me he was not interested in speaking with one of our drug detectives at this time. Both [redacted] and [redacted] who is also an addict, relayed to me they were familiar with the Blue HART program and were considering applying.

Det. Puccio #259 of DEU was contacted and advised of the incident. The syringe was safely disposed of at the hospital and the CDS and paraphernalia were entered into property for destruction.
