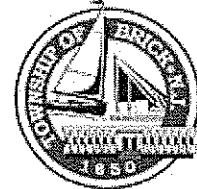

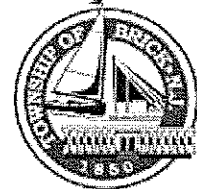

## OfficerID: mmiller, Narrative

On 3/1/19 at approximately 2017 hours Ptl. Bennett (#279) and I were dispatched to [redacted] in reference to an overdose. Dispatch advised a fifty year old male was semi conscious.

Upon arrival I met with the resident / caller [redacted]. [redacted] escorted me to the kitchen where I observed her live in boyfriend, [redacted] standing near a chair. His eyes were closed, he was trembling, and did not respond to verbal commands. I was able to get [redacted] seated and wake him with a sternum rub. When [redacted] woke he only stated he was tired.

At this time members of BTPD Med unit 534 arrived and took over assisting [redacted]. I was able to speak with [redacted] and ask what had happened. [redacted] advised me she was home alone, when [redacted] returned home at approximately 2000 hours. [redacted] stated she immediately noticed he was not right. [redacted] stated [redacted] retrieved a beer from the refrigerator, and immediately dropped it. [redacted] stated she picked up the can and began cleaning up the spill. As [redacted] attempted to reclaim the beer, [redacted] stated she observed his eyes roll back and his body began shaking. [redacted] stated she shook [redacted] and yelled at him, but there was no response. That's when she called for help.

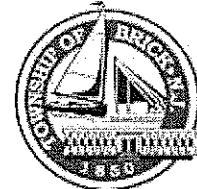
[redacted] advised me she did not see [redacted] ingest anything other than his beer, but stated he has a long history of abusing prescription pills. [redacted] stated she believed [redacted] may have taken something while he was out.

While dealing with [redacted] he was in and out of consciousness. When asked repeatedly, [redacted] denied taking any type of drug. [redacted] was placed into the ambulance for transport. Prior to leaving, [redacted] informed Ptl. Bennett (#279) that he had taken a "Roxy" early in the day. He did not know the dosage, and could only relate that it was still daylight when he took it.

[redacted] was transported to the Ocean Medical Center for evaluation. Det. Sgt. Petrola (#201) was advised of the situation.

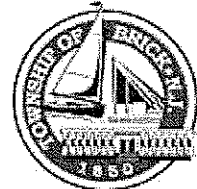
On arrival I observed a male subject matching that description sitting on the ground by the entrance. I asked the subject his name and he advised it was [redacted] stated that he messaged his girlfriend to get him help because he all of a sudden felt tired and was unable to walk home. [redacted] advised that he did want to go to the hospital.

When asked if he took any drugs or medication [redacted] stated that he took two percaset's that were not prescribed to him at 1000 hours on 03/11/19. [redacted] stated that he was given the percaset's from a friend named [redacted] from Seaside NJ. [redacted] also advised that before leaving his house to walk to 7-11 he took his prescribed Lithium, Abilify, Gabapentin, Vistaril, and Zofran which he believes counteracted with the percaset's.

[redacted] was transported to Ocean Medical Center by Lakewood EMS. I contacted Det. Puccio #259 about the incident and he advised that he would not be responding.

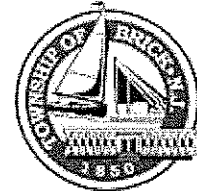

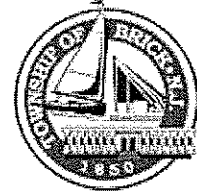

On 03/12/2019 at 1307 hours Ptl. Heschle #135, Detective Waleski #157, Ptl. Williams #220, Sgt. Kelly #241, Ptl. Knehr #295, and I (Ptl. Newlund #285) responded to [redacted] for a report of a drug overdose. Dispatch advised all patrol units that one of the teachers was beginning to perform CPR on the subject, but it was not confirmed on scene if CPR was ever administered. Upon police arrival, the subject (later identified as [redacted]) was found in the bathroom sitting up alert and conscious. A syringe and empty wax fold (containing a red stamp stating "SUPREME") was located in the immediate area of [redacted]. A teacher at the institute advised the syringe was located in [redacted]'s arm when the bathroom door was opened with a key. Ptl. Williams searched [redacted]'s jacket and located both empty and full wax folds of suspected heroin. [redacted] advised she had some empty wax folds in her car and in her black bag with school supplies. [redacted] stated she used one wax fold earlier in the day and one wax fold before passing out. [redacted] was transported to OMC for medical evaluation.

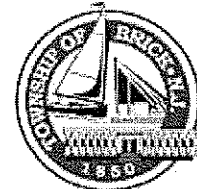
I spoke with [redacted] (student who located [redacted] unconscious). [redacted] stated she heard another student state that someone was in the bathroom for 20 minutes so she got up to check for herself. [redacted] advised she contacted a teacher with a key to open the door after she knocked on the door with no response returned. [redacted] stated the teacher advised her the door is probably stuck and to attempt to force it open. [redacted] explained she went back to the bathroom door and looked under the door and observed a female laying on the ground. [redacted] further explained she notified a teacher and someone else to call 911.

I contacted Detective Alvarado #221 of the drug unit and advised him of the situation. Wax folds containing suspected heroin were entered into the evidence room for destruction. Empty wax folds, a q-tip, bottle cap, and syringe cap were entered into property for destruction. The syringe was disposed of at Ocean Medical Center.

This incident was recorded on a department issued body worn camera.

## OfficerID: coliverio, Narrative

On 03/14/2019 at 2354 hours, Sgt. Dierking #204, Ptl. Bennett #279 and I (Pt. Oliverio #286) responded to [REDACTED] in reference to a first aid call. Dispatch advised the caller, [REDACTED], stated her twenty-six (26) year old son was in an active seizure.

Upon arrival I located [REDACTED] and her son, [REDACTED], in their living room. [REDACTED] was laying on his right side curled up in the prone position. His pupils were pin point, his breathing was shallow and he was unresponsive. At this time it apparent [REDACTED] was not in an active seizure but was overdosing.

Brick EMS #536 and MONOC arrived on scene and began life saving measures. At 0001 hours one (1) dose of 4mg Narcan was administered by Brick EMS. [REDACTED] then became responsive and was placed in the back of the ambulance in order to be transported to Ocean Medical Center for further treatment.

I then spoke to [REDACTED] who stated the following: She was alerted by her mother, [REDACTED], that [REDACTED] was laying by the T. V in the living room crying. When she checked on [REDACTED] she found him on the floor shaking, believing he was having a seizure she contacted 911.

I then spoke with [REDACTED], who stated the following: [REDACTED] came into her room to speak with her, because he knew she was upset with him. She was upset because [REDACTED] did not come home for two (2) days and she believed he was in Kearney with his father. When she refused to talk to [REDACTED] he began to cry and left her room. [REDACTED] walked to the living room and laid down on the floor. When [REDACTED] did not stop crying she alerted her daughter.

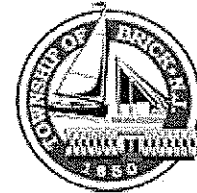
I located multiple wax folds with the stamp "Scotch and Soda" in blue ink located in [REDACTED]'s wallet. I was also able to locate one empty wax fold with the same stamp located in a trash bin in [REDACTED]'s bedroom.

All evidence was logged in to property labeled to be destroyed.

Det. Puccio #259 of Brick Township Drug Enforcement Unit was advised of the incident.

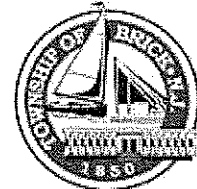

On 03/16/2019 at approximately 1238 hours, Ptl. Scelfo #189, Ptl. Carter #280, and I, Ptl. Caulfield #235, responded to in reference to an unconscious female. Dispatch had advised that two children, ages 9 and 10, had discovered their mother unconscious inside the house and had called their mother's boyfriend to alert help.

Upon arrival, the female's boyfriend, identified as , directed officers to a downstairs bedroom where the female was. Also on scene were the two children, identified as and . The female, identified as , was lying in said room on a mattress on the floor. s skin was pale, her breathing was agnail, and she was unconscious. quickly reported that has a history of heroin use and stated that she has overdosed in similar circumstances in the past.

I then administered one dose of Naloxone (Narcan) 4mg inside iostril. Brick Police EMS and MONOC medics arrived on scene shortly thereafter. Within 3 minutes of administering the Narcan, became conscious and coherent. admitted that she had snorted/ingested one bag of heroin which was white colored (Unknown stamp). reported that she didn't know where the used bag of heroin was. A check of the bedroom and bathroom next to the bedroom yielded negative result for the used bag of heroin.

I then spoke with about what had occurred. reported that he and are in a dating relationship and reside together in Toms River, NJ. stated her two children, and him all stayed at the residence. from last night (03/15/19) until today while he, was doing carpentry work inside the house. reported that he left the house at approximately 1220 hours to get McDonald's food for him and the children. While at McDonald's in Brick, NJ. received a call from on of who reported that his mother was unconscious and barely breathing. hen called 911 to report condition.

I then spoke with and about what had occurred. reported that he was inside his mother's bedroom playing a hand held Nintendo game while was inside another downstairs bedroom also playing Nintendo. reported that while sitting on the bed with his mother, he saw his mother, , awake and talking then observed her falling asleep. , stated he heard his mother's breathing become more distressed at which time he tried waking her up which yielded negative results. - said he then pulled his mother's eyelids open and could only see the white of her eyes. At that time, realized something was wrong with his mother and called via cell phone. and stated that they live with their father, , in South Toms River, NJ and haven't seen their mother, , in approximately 6 months. It's unknown at this time if has custody of the children as part of a Family Court Custody Order.

Pt. Scelfo made contact with and advised him of the situation. A short time later, arrived on scene and took custody of the two children. was transported by Brick PD EMS to Ocean Medical Center in Brick, NJ for further treatment. Due to the overdose occurring in the children's presence, I then contacted DCP&P and spoke with a female employee, identified as Belinda ID#1384. Belinda advised that the case would be assigned to the DCP&P Ocean County, NJ South Office and that employees from DCP&P would be responding to residence in South Toms River, NJ to speak with the two children further. A Ocean County Naloxone Deployment Reporting Form was completed and filed with this case. Det. Puccio #259, Brick PD DEU, was notified of the incident as well.
