Dorothy escorted me to ~~Mikaela's~~ bedroom, where she was lying in bed. When speaking with ~~Mikaela~~, she appeared alert however she was lethargic and it appeared uncomfortable for her to move. I asked her about what medications she consumed to which she stated, she took ~~six Ativan pills~~ and she could not remember what else. When asked if she was suicidal, she claimed she was not. She also stated she was unsure if there were any remaining pills left or where the might be. I conducted a search of the area for any evidence of what pills she consumed with negative results.

~~Mikaela~~ was then examined by Quality First Aid, and was voluntarily transported to Centra State Medical Center via ambulance.

Dorothy claimed she would search for any other pills around the house and discard them if located. No further police action required at this time.

After approximately 2 to 3 minutes I administered narkan to the victim. A short time later the victim regained consciousness and was answering questions from first aid. The victim was then identified as [REDACTED] [REDACTED] repeatedly stated to first aid that he did not take any narcotics.

Officers searched the area for evidence and [REDACTED] while he was unconscious in attempt to ascertain information for first aid . No evidence was collected on scene that could point to what type of narcotic [REDACTED] may have taken.

[REDACTED] Matthew's mother, Norma Wasilko, who eventually arrived on scene stated that [REDACTED] has been in rehab before for heroin abuse.

[REDACTED] was transported to Monmouth Medical Center South by the Jackson First Aid Squad.
