ON SEPTEMBER 2, 2018, AT 1801 HOURS PTL. BRUNO, PTL. A. ALTMAN, PTL. ALLEN AND MYSELF WERE DISPATCHED TO [REDACTED] SPRAY AVE FOR A POSSIBLE OVERDOSE. UPON ARRIVAL WE WERE MET BY [REDACTED] MR. [REDACTED] ADVISED ME THE VICTIM [REDACTED] WAS LOCATED IN THE DOWNSTAIRS BATHROOM UNCONSCIOUS AND POSSIBLY OVERDOSED. I LOCATED [REDACTED] IN THE BATHROOM AND HE WAS UNRESPONSIVE WITH A WEAK PULSE. BASED ON THE INFORMATION RECEIVED, NARCAN WAS ADMINISTRATED. AFTER A COUPLE OF MINUTES [REDACTED] BECAME RESPONSIVE AND CONSCIOUS. SOUTH TOMS RIVER EMS AND MONOC ARRIVED ON LOCATION AND TOOK OVER CARE. SOUTH TOMS RIVER EMS AND MONOC TRANSPORTED THE VICTIM TO COMMUNITY MEDICAL CENTER FOR TREATMENT.

NARCAN DEPLOYMENT FORM WAS COMPLETED AND FAXED. OIC SGT. MELILLO WAS NOTIFIED OF THE OVERDOSE. NARCAN WAS REPLENISHED AT COMMUNITY MEDICAL CENTER.
