Arrived at the complaint location and I met with a staff member who indicated that he was the only associate in the store. I inquired as to any complaints that have surfaced in the store but he was unaware of a complaint. I walked through the store front and I observed 14 dogs on site. One dog was roaming the store unleashed. I inquired as to the one dog roaming and he explained that he allowed for the dog to roam as a sales tactic.

I observed the primary housings of the other dogs and the pens were matted with wood shavings and excreta was visible in all pens. I observed the wood shavings as mixing with the food and water the animals were ingesting. I inquired as to the cleaning routine in place and the associate stated that when time is permissible he would address the store cleaning.

I stated to the associate that currently the conditions are not acceptable and that correction is required. I will issue a NOV for facility cleanliness, potable water, and palatable food.

Arrived at the complaint location and I met with owner who as currently in the process of cleaning the store and cages. The store front is clean and free from any wood shavings found within the primary enclosures. The dogs observed appear active and healthy. The dogs currently have food and water that is clean. The owner explained that extra efforts have gone into maintaining the store and keeping the cages clean. I indicated that this was appropriate and that any deviation from the current conditions could result in action being taken against the store.

Currently the store is clean and the animals appear to be well kept. No further action will be required.

Arrived at the complaint location and I met with the business owner Pat Youmans. I reinspected the facility to verify his compliance. Currently the facility has 28 dogs on site. None of the dogs required being placed in isolation. Dogs that were for sale had all the appropriate identification information in view of the public. All primary enclosures were clean and free of any excreta. All dogs appeared active and healthy. Clean food and water were available for the dogs. No other adverse conditions were observed. The facility is currently operating in satisfactory condition.
