A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BERKELEY APPOINTING A ZONING PROSECUTOR FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF BERKELEY

January 1, 2018

WHEREAS, the Township of Berkeley is in need of legal counsel for Zoning Prosecutor matters which must be rendered or performed by a person authorized by law, and which such services otherwise constitute "professional services" within the meaning of N.J.S.A. 40A:11-2(6); and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5 authorizes the award of a contract for such "professional services" without public advertising for bids; and

WHEREAS, the Township Attorney in the capacity of Director of Law Chapter 2-30.3 of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Berkeley, as promulgated pursuant to the Optional Municipal Charter Law, Dina M. Vicari and Michael Deem as Municipal Zoning Prosecutor; and

WHEREAS, the term of this contract is until December 31, 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of Berkeley, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, that Dina M. Vicari and Michael Deem are hereby appointed as Municipal Zoning Prosecutor for the Township of Berkeley for a period of one (1) year commencing January 1, 2018 and ending December 31, 2018.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Township Clerk are authorized to execute contracts which shall be available for public examination in the office of the Township Clerk during normal business hours for Dina M. Vicari and Michael Deem to act as Municipal Zoning Prosecutor; and

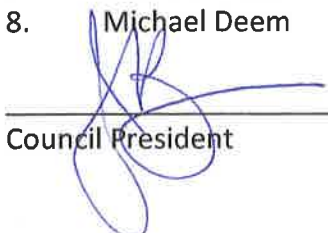
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the appointment of Dina M. Vicari and Michael Deem as Municipal Zoning Officer is made in accordance with the provisions of P.L. 1996, Chapter 95. Said Municipal Zoning Prosecutor shall serve under the supervision of the Attorney General or the Ocean County Prosecutor and may represent the State, County or Municipality in any matter within the jurisdiction of the Municipal Court; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that notice of this action shall be printed once in the official newspaper of the Township of Berkeley; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Business Disclosure Entity Certification and the determination of value be placed on file with this Resolution; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that certified copies of the within Resolution shall be forwarded to the following:

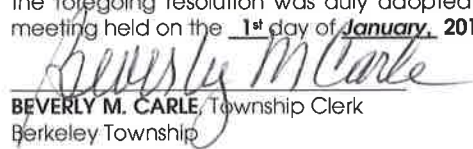
