The Town of Secaucus received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on June 23, 2026. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is July 2, 2026. Please accept this letter in response to your request.

Your OPRA request sought access to the following:

“Please provide an updated, comprehensive roster/list of all current employees (both sworn law enforcement officers and non-sworn civilian staff) employed by the Secaucus Police Department. The data should be in an electronic format (such as an Excel spreadsheet or PDF), including the following specific columns/information for each individual employee:

- Full Name (First and Last)**
- Current Title/Rank (e.g., Officer, Sergeant, Lieutenant)/ Position**
- Badge Number / Employee Identification Number**
- Current Base Salary and Year-to-Date (YTD) Earnings**
- Date of Hire”**

Please see attached files in response to your request. Certain information contained within the responsive records has been redacted. These redactions have been made to protect confidential personal identifying information pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1. These records are being transmitted to you via email, as per your request. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5.b., the cost associated with this request is \$0.00.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Town of Secaucus to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
