Dear Mayor and City Council:

On Wednesday, January 9, 2019 bids were received in the City Hall for the above referenced project. As indicated on the attached bid tabulation sheet, two (2) bids were received.

The apparent low base bid was submitted by Foggia Trinity Electric, LLC of Scotch Plains, New Jersey, with a base bid of \$317,772.65. Our office has worked with Foggia Trinity Electric, LLC. in the past with satisfactory results.

As you are aware, we included one (1) Deletion item in the contract in case the bids received were higher than the funds provided for same. Utilization of Deletion Item No. 1 would delete improvements at the intersection of Avenue E and 35th Street. The low bid utilizing Deletion Item No. 1 would be \$217,293.40, also by Foggia Trinity Electric, LLC.

The New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) awarded the City a 2013 Safe Streets to Transit Grant in the amount of \$205,000.00 for the above referenced project. The NJDOT has indicated that since the grant has not been utilized by the City, the grant may be rescinded if a contract is not awarded in a timely manner. Therefore, it is recommended that the project be awarded to Foggia Trinity Electric, LLC, utilizing Deletion Item No. 1 in the amount of \$217,293.40 subject to the concurrence of the City Corporation Counsel, and the availability of sufficient funds. In addition, the Resolution of Award should include a condition that the award is subject to the approval of the NJDOT.

By copy of this letter, we have enclosed the original bids received from Foggia Trinity Electric, LLC, and J.C. Contracting to be kept on file with the City Clerk.
