The EC-40 Series Perflex Filter Systems have the capacity to deliver 2400 gallons of filtered water per hour (40 gpm). This filtration rate provides an 8-hour turnover for a 19,000 gallon pool; and a faster turnover rate for pools of smaller capacity. The EC-50 has a 50 gpm rating (3000 gallons per hour) and provides extra capacity for larger pools.
