This office is in receipt of your requests for records under the New Jersey Open Public Records Act (OPRA). The responses to each of your requests are set forth below.

1. Records sufficient to show the name, title/position, date of hire, and current salary for all current employees.

Please see the attached. Please be advised that the dates of hire reflected in the document responsive to this request are the dates of hire with the County of Ocean.

2. Records sufficient to show payroll data, including base salary and overtime compensation, for all employees.

Please see the attached.

3. Records sufficient to show all separations of employment, including retirements, resignations, and terminations, including the date and reason for separation.

Please see the attached.

4. Records of final agency disciplinary actions, including but not limited to suspensions, terminations, or demotions.

Please be advised that any such records in this office's possession do not consist of government records under OPRA as they are considered personnel records that are exempt from disclosure under OPRA, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-10. Therefore, this request is denied. Notwithstanding and without waiving this objection, the document provided in response to number 3 of this request reflects the employees who were terminated during the relevant time period.

5. Records sufficient to show the number of internal affairs or professional standards complaints received and the disposition of such complaints (e.g., sustained, not sustained, exonerated, unfounded), for the time period requested.

Please see the attached.

6. Any settlement agreements involving employees.

This office has been unable to locate any documents responsive to this request.

7. Any records sufficient to show outside employment disclosures or conflict-of-interest filings, if maintained.

With regard to your request for "records sufficient to show outside employment disclosures," please be advised that any such records in this office's possession do not consist of government records under OPRA as they are considered personnel records that are exempt from disclosure under OPRA, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-10. Therefore, this request is denied.

Your request for "conflict-of-interest filings" is impermissibly vague and overbroad because it does not identify specific documents; instead, it is a general request for information to be researched and produced, which is prohibited by the OPRA statute. As stated by the Court in MAG Entm't, LLC v. Div. of Alcoholic Beverage Control, 375 N.J. Super. 534, 546 (App. Div. 2005),

While OPRA provides an alternative means of access to government documents not otherwise exempted from its reach, it is not intended as a research tool litigants may use to force government officials to identify and siphon useful information. Rather, OPRA simply operates to make identifiable government records "readily accessible for inspection, copying, or examination."

Therefore, this request is denied.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council ("GRC") by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at Government.Records@dca.nj.gov or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The Council can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior

Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.

Should you disagree with our decision, please contact us in writing with your concerns so that we may consider them. If I can be of further assistance, please do not hesitate to contact me.
