Just as a follow-up on my end, I did speak with Scott Murphy a week or two ago and should the code be separated out for the BOH, General Code would need communication on how to proceed with using existing code to create a new section of code for the BOH. The Borough is currently in the process of updating our code at this time, and it would be necessary for the BOH to contact them as soon as possible to start the process of creating a separate section. Based on the decisions made on how to create the code, they can provide pricing.

Lenora, I have copied in Patty from General Code as she has been the one with all the great answers from General Code. Please see her response to your question.

Oftentimes what we see is that the BOH portion is not necessarily large enough to warrant its own separate volume (picture a binder with only 50-100 pages in it.... and 100 pages of text is only 50 pieces of paper). So typically we include the BOH within the same volume but in a separate Part of the Code (e.g., that Part III, BOH, example); and that Part is reserved for only legislation adopted by the BOH.

If the Borough's BOH legislation is extensive in size (200+ pages, which is 100 pieces of paper) and you do want a separate volume, we can definitely accommodate a separate volume.

Another consideration is if the Borough wants more or fewer copies of the BOH volume than of the main Code. If BOH will be the same number of copies, it can be housed in the same binder. But if the quantity is different, then a separate volume is the way to go, regardless of size. (A simple 3-ring binder can always be used if the size of the BOH legislation is small.)
