I advised Mr. Burtis that this interaction was being recorded visually and audibly. Mr. Burtis stated he was also recording us and we must be there for him. I asked Mr. Burtis what was going on and he stated he was flying his drone in the area when he was approached by Mr. Eggert whom appeared angry. Words were exchanged between the two parties and Mr. Eggert left the area. I advised Mr. Burtis some of the rules of flying a drone which he stated he understood.

Upon arrival to Lee Eggert's home I was greeted by Lee and Dale Eggert whom stated they were annoyed with Mr. Burtis. I advised the Eggerts that Mr. Burtis has the right to fly his drone as long as he was abiding by the rules and regulations. The Eggerts had some choice words for Mr. Burtis and preceded to inform us the reason for the issues between the parties. After a short conversation we cleared the scene as both parties appeared satisfied.
