There have been ushers in the Great Auditorium since its first service on July 1, 1894. The first official report of the Auditorium Ushers was made at the close of the 1897 season by then Vice President of the Ocean Grove Camp Meeting Association, Dr. Aaron Ballard. In 1898 the OGCMA appointed a committee to take charge of ushering and the Ocean Grove Auditorium Ushers Association was formed.

Presently, there are 134 men ages 18 to 90+ who serve, or carry an interest in the duties of the ushers, with 87 actively serving at more than 111 events. Many families have multiple generational members as fathers, sons, brothers, uncles and grandsons all proudly serve. There is one man actively serving his 77th season, another at 71 and 5 more with more than 50 seasons serving the Lord. There are 5 honorary members also with more than 50 years of involvement.

The 2021 season tested our organizational abilities and highlighted the members' desire to return to normal. Member surveys in March/April revealed that most had or were planning to receive covid-19 vaccinations and all but one who had health issues planned to usher this year.

We were still not sure what the Governor or the CDC were going to recommend, so we purchased gloves, masks and tables to support collection baskets. We were prepared to receive contactless donations, but planned to reinstate the famed "Ushers March" no matter how funds were received.

Also affected by uncertainty was the collection by the Ladies auxiliary. Traditionally, they would take over the service on Fathers' Day, but we deferred to August 8 and had to meet a new challenge involving ushering in the balcony. The ladies stepped up and all went well.

We supported 16 Sunday services with an average of 60 ushers each week, handled 10 weeks (60 sessions) of Bible Hour, 17 Organ concerts, 5 summer stars concerts, 3 band concerts, 6 Songs on a Sunday Afternoon and a crowd of 5000 at Bridgefest. For a total of 2212 man hours in the Auditorium and 504 in the Bishop Janes Tabernacle. In addition we exhibited ambassadorship interacting with the community while supporting the Independence Day Parade, the Craft show, Praisefest (July 17), Victorian Day & The Ladies Bazaar.

Unfortunately, we were heavily affected by the deaths of 13 men in the 2020 and 2021 season. Many of them were steadfast servants at almost every event. In addition, 8 others moved or retired for health reasons. Conversely we gained 2 new members in 2020 and 7 in 2021.

Ushering is not limited to collecting on Sunday mornings, we are there to ensure the safety and comfort of everyone at all of the events in the Great Auditorium which included Organ Concerts on Wednesday and Saturday, along with Sunday's "Songs on a Summer Afternoon" and Bible Hour in the Tabernacle.

In addition to generational families, we have many men serving for generations!

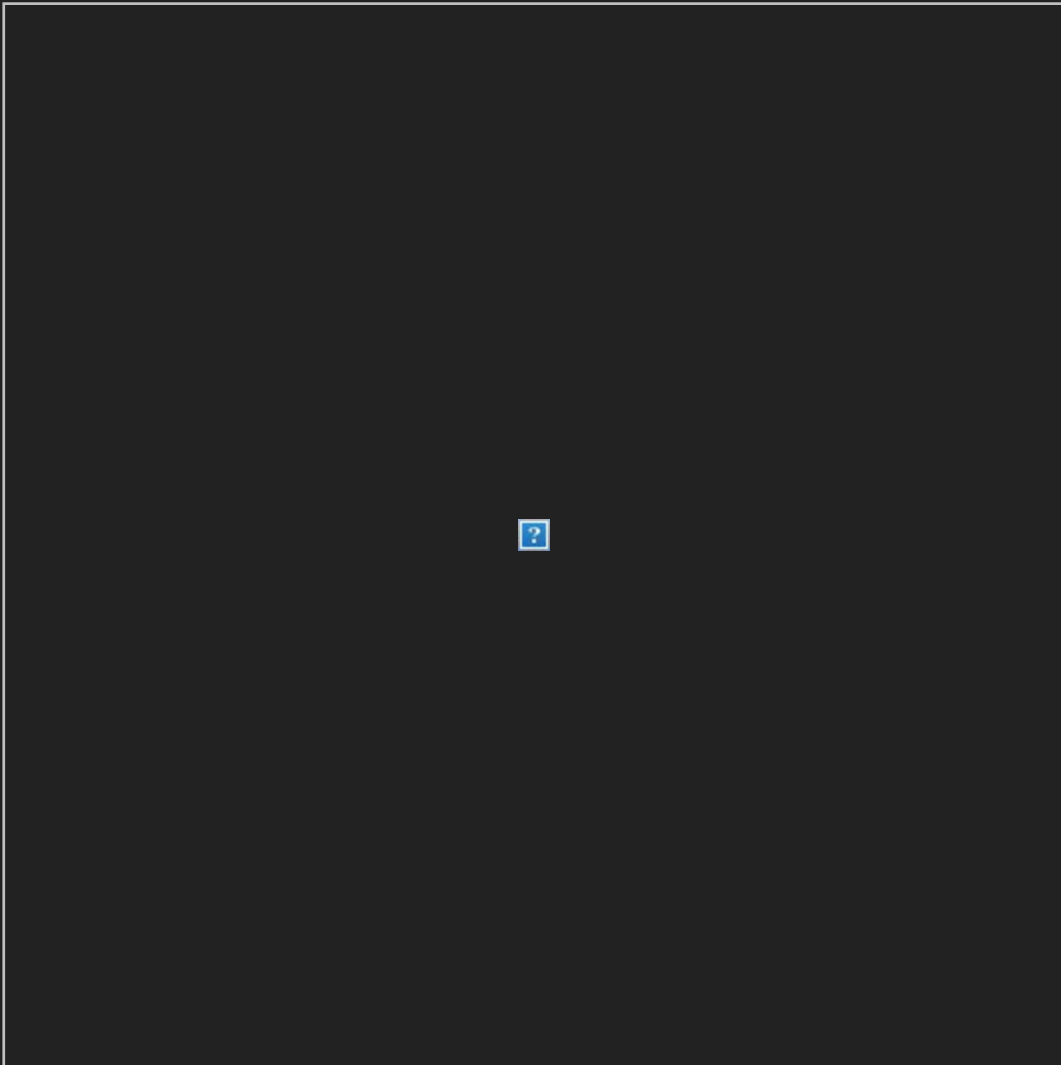
This year Jed Schroeder reached his 71st season ushering in the North Balcony and

Joe Allison, Richard Deetz, Doug Hampson & Steve Downing are celebrating their 20th season. These are just some examples of the dedicated men who love Ocean Grove and love serving the Lord. Charles Golden is stepping down

after 5 years as director in the Tabernacle and Phil Beachy will replace him in 2022. During Charles 15 years as an usher he exemplified the type of dedication we see from many of our members. He attended Bible hour 6 days a week, assisted with Saturday night events when we had them and then ushered at Sunday morning and evening services with a Song on a Sunday afternoon in-between. 7 days a week, twice on Saturday and thrice on Sunday!

Oh yes, some organ concerts and Summer Stars to boot.

It takes 84 men to fill all of the Auditorium stations but we manage with an average of 60 to 65 each Sunday.

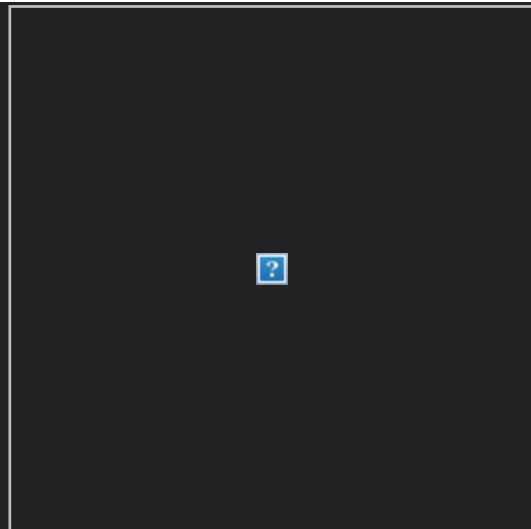
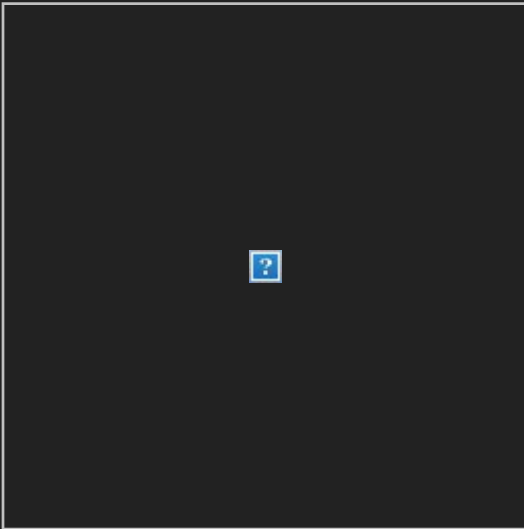
2021 felt a little more like the summer's of Ocean Grove past.

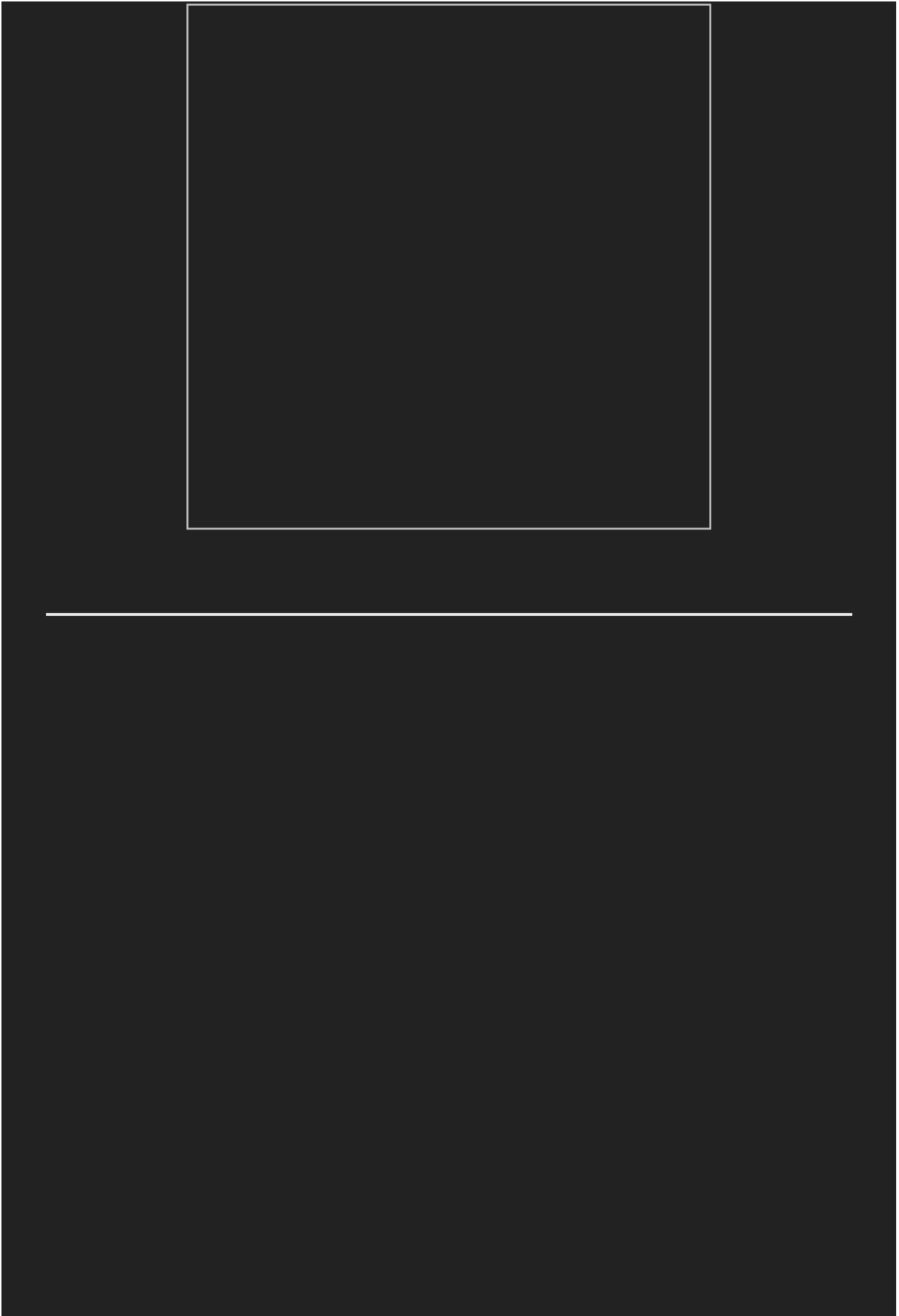
Even in a pandemic, we were still able to continue to offer many of the events and activities that the

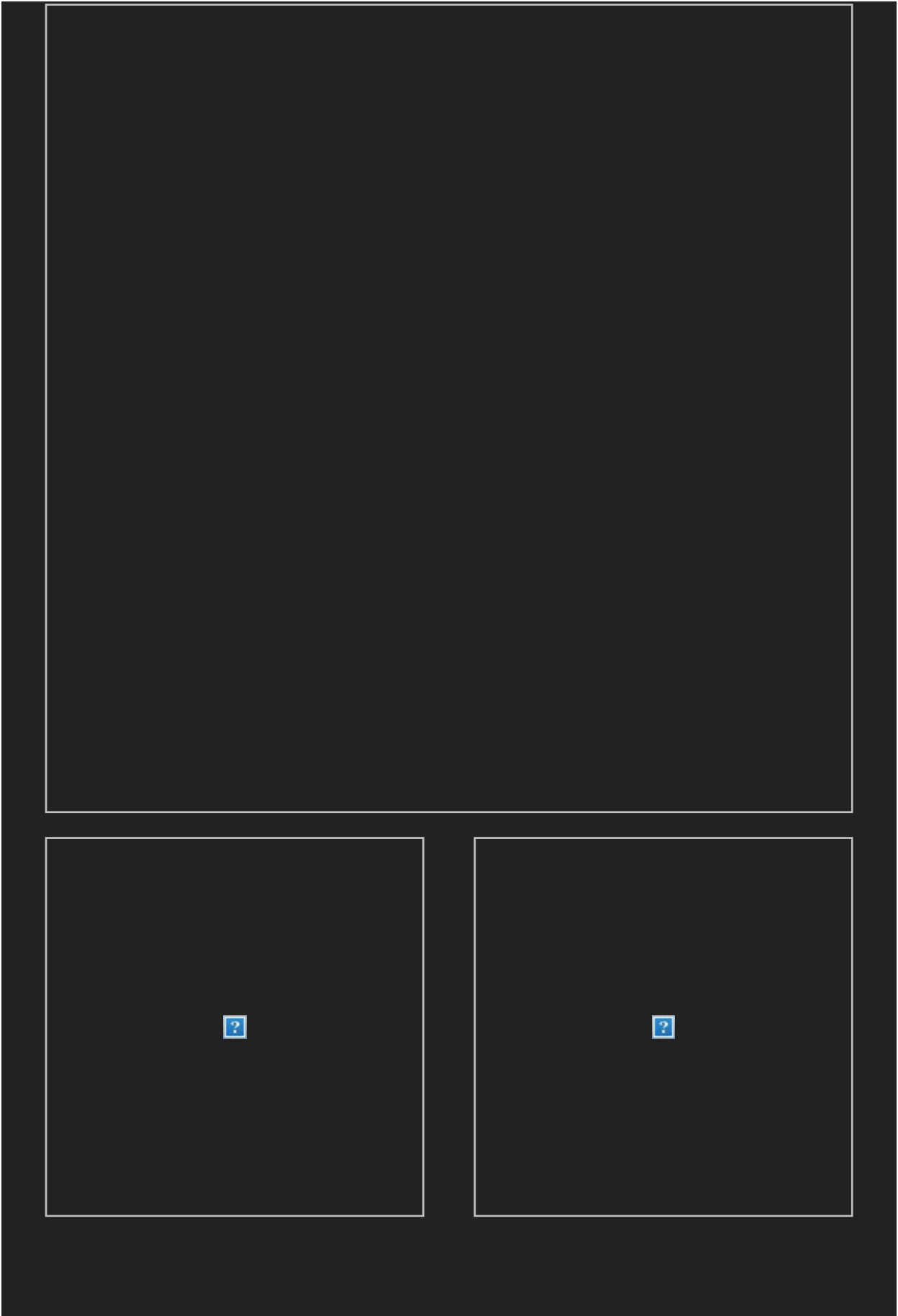

Mayor Cafferty - The OGHOA has a very important February 25th Membership Meeting which is two days before your next Township Meeting on the 27th. Our members are clamoring for, and we will have on our agenda, a thorough update on the status of the Township and the RPPP proposal. Will we be able to report that the proposal will be on the agenda for your Meeting on the 27th?

As you witnessed at the last Township Meeting on Monday, the carnival of people commenting on the proposal will be an ongoing event. Clearly a huge number of residents are for the proposal, especially the actual residents in the northwest quadrant - and yes, there are people opposed, a good many of whom have been "mobilized" by the CMA. You know that, and I see no benefit for you to keep learning that through more agonizing public comment sessions, emails and polls. You will not be able to make everyone happy. Why can't the Township just be proactive, approve the proposal, take aggressive ownership of the project, and let's move on to other pressing issues in town.

The very model for taking ownership of projects is what you do repeatedly in your recreation accomplishments: the skateboard park, jump track, frisbee golf course, and upcoming pickleball courts are not projects you finally gave in to because the public was hammering you. You identified needs, took input, internally developed solutions, found the money, made them happen, and touted the accomplishments. Let's put a trial proposal for permit parking in a quadrant of Ocean Grove into this model of making projects happen.

Would like to talk on the phone briefly about two things. What is the scope of work and status of the Broadway tennis/pickleball court repairs?

The OGCMA has a tenant selling the building at [100 Lake Ave](#). Over the years, both Neptune Township and the OGCMA objected to the encroachment of the porches and landscaping into the public area. The three stories of porches may have been in existence for decades. It might be reasonable to allow the porches to remain intact. I will recommend altering or removing the retaining wall(s) and landscaping north of the porches. Before the OGCMA makes that decision, your thoughts are welcome.

Gina, Michael, and David,

The OGCMA requests Neptune Township fund the restoration of the Broadway courts. Attached is a Memorandum For Record (MFR) of our Nov 10th online meeting.

Work began on the site on Nov 14th. Four recent images of the site are provided for your attention. The construction has extended far into the north side pickleball court and even past the tennis baseline. This current state of the project heightens my concerns which were raised on Nov 10th. The present condition of the site is unsafe and unsatisfactory. The hanging fence, strewn cones, and tripping pitfalls renders the area unsightly and hazardous. The pictures taken inside the outflow end of the culvert depict crumbling concrete, rusted rebar, and gaps where sunlight comes through. I request that the OGCMA be provided with a signed and seal document from a professional engineer that certifies the safety and structural integrity of the remaining culvert.

There have been ushers in the Great Auditorium since its first service on July 1, 1894. The first official report of the Auditorium Ushers was made at the close of the 1897 season by then Vice President of the Ocean Grove Camp Meeting Association, Dr. Aaron Ballard. In 1898 the OGCMA appointed a committee to take charge of ushering and the Ocean Grove Auditorium Ushers Association was formed.

Presently, there are 134 men ages 18 to 90+ who serve, or carry an interest in the duties of the ushers, with 87 actively serving at more than 111 events. Many families have multiple generational members as fathers, sons, brothers, uncles and grandsons all proudly serve. There is one man actively serving his 77th season, another at 71 and 5 more with more than 50 seasons serving the Lord. There are 5 honorary members also with more than 50 years of involvement.

The 2021 season tested our organizational abilities and highlighted the members' desire to return to normal. Member surveys in March/April revealed that most had or were planning to receive covid-19 vaccinations and all but one who had health issues planned to usher this year.

We were still not sure what the Governor or the CDC were going to recommend, so we purchased gloves, masks and tables to support collection baskets. We were prepared to receive contactless donations, but planned to reinstate the famed "Ushers March" no matter how funds were received.

Also affected by uncertainty was the collection by the Ladies auxiliary. Traditionally, they would take over the service on Fathers' Day, but we deferred to August 8 and had to meet a new challenge involving ushering in the balcony. The ladies stepped up and all went well.

We supported 16 Sunday services with an average of 60 ushers each week, handled 10 weeks (60 sessions) of Bible Hour, 17 Organ concerts, 5 summer stars concerts, 3 band concerts, 6 Songs on a Sunday Afternoon and a crowd of 5000 at Bridgefest. For a total of 2212 man hours in the Auditorium and 504 in the Bishop Janes Tabernacle. In addition we exhibited ambassadorship interacting with the community while supporting the Independence Day Parade, the Craft show, Praisefest (July 17), Victorian Day & The Ladies Bazaar.

Unfortunately, we were heavily affected by the deaths of 13 men in the 2020 and 2021 season. Many of them were steadfast servants at almost every event. In addition, 8 others moved or retired for health reasons. Conversely we gained 2 new members in 2020 and 7 in 2021.

Ushering is not limited to collecting on Sunday mornings, we are there to ensure the safety and comfort of everyone at all of the events in the Great Auditorium which included Organ Concerts on Wednesday and Saturday, along with Sunday's "Songs on a Summer Afternoon" and Bible Hour in the Tabernacle.

In addition to generational families, we have many men serving for generations!

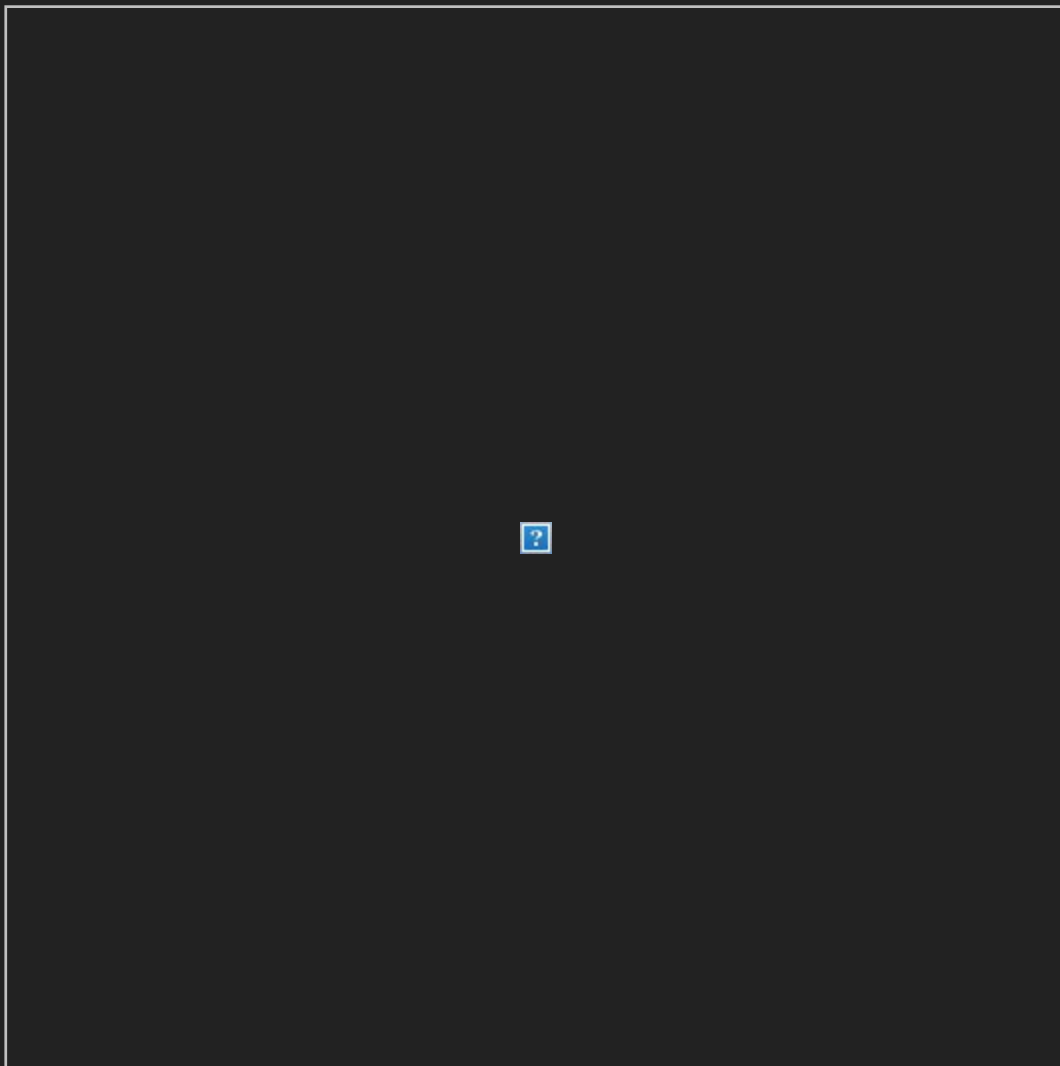
This year Jed Schroeder reached his 71st season ushering in the North Balcony and
