Minutes for the Special Meeting of the City Council, City of Pleasantville, New Jersey held on March 15, 2023, 1:00 p.m., City Hall, 2nd floor conference room, 18 N First Street, Pleasantville, New Jersey, with President Cistrunk presiding.

President Cistrunk stated that this meeting has been duly advertised in the City newspaper in conformance with the Open Public Meetings Act, otherwise known as the Sunshine Law.

President Cistrunk led the Invocation and Flag Salute.

On a motion by Councilman Davenport and duly seconded by Councilman Carmona, the meeting closed for executive session. All were in favor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Pleasantville that a closed session shall be held on Wednesday, March 15, 2023, 1:00 p.m., at City Hall, 2nd floor conference room, 18 N First Street, Pleasantville, New Jersey, to discuss the above subject matter. It is expected that the discussions undertaken in closed session will be made public at the time a decision of the matter is rendered.
