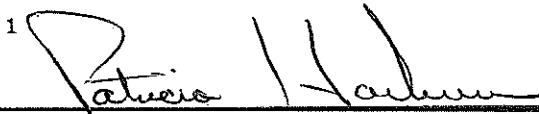

78. Narrative

On 03/17/2019, I S/O M. McMahon, was dispatched to [REDACTED] for a unresponsive individual. Upon my arrival I witnessed rescue giving CPR to the victim who was later identified as [REDACTED]. During CPR, AED pads were placed and a electrical shock was administered [REDACTED] via AED. At this point [REDACTED] still did not have a pulse and I then administered Narcan Nasal spray 4mg inside her left nostril. Next within approximately 1 minute after Narcan was administered, [REDACTED] had regained a pulse. She was then transported by Rescue to 921 Lafayette street to be flown out via medevac helicopter.

Next while rescue and paramedics were giving treatment, [REDACTED]
