Narrative

Toms River Police Department Investigation Narrative

On 10-1-16, I was dispatched to 180 Yellowbank Road in reference to a police information report. Upon arrival, I spoke with Elizabeth Wilson and her [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] informed me of the following:

At 1417 this afternoon, [REDACTED] was seated in a chair in the front yard of [REDACTED] residence when [REDACTED] observed a subject dressed in a bright yellow outfit with a white face walking along the wood line at the dead end of Yellowbank Road. [REDACTED] stated that the subject did not communicate with anyone and continued walking into the woods of Cattus Island Park, but [REDACTED] was able to take a photo (see attached). [REDACTED] also stated that due to the fact that [REDACTED] had [REDACTED] iPhone set to black and white for photos, the image does not show the colors the subject was wearing. In addition to that, the distance from the subject resulted in a very grainy photograph.

Elizabeth stated that her children play with the children at 180 Yellowbank Road so she walked across the street to inform them of the incident and inquire as to whether or not their children observed the subject.

All subjects at the residence were instructed to call the police department should they see the subject in the area again.
