Narrative

On the above date and time I was on patrol in the area of Route 17 North and Mountainside Ave. and observed a vehicle in the right lane of travel with its lights on, just past the Mountainside Exit. The vehicle was bearing NY [REDACTED]. I advised headquarters I'd be conducting a motor vehicle stop and activated my emergency lights. The driver later identified as Heather Anne Viol immediately exited the vehicle and stood at the rear of her vehicle. As I approached Miss Viol began to talk to me as if she was waiting for me and stated I know why your here. Miss Viol was very energetic and told to stand on the side of the road several times while she was talking. Miss Viol stated that the man she is dating (Saul) called the police on her and stated several times she knew why I was there. While speaking with Miss Viol I observed bags of clothing piled up in her car and a cat was inside the vehicle as well. The vehicle was in poor condition and was missing it's rear bumper. I asked Miss Viol why her boyfriend called the police on her and she stated he doesn't want me around. I asked Miss Viol where she was coming from and where she was attempting to go. Miss Viol stated she was on her way to Saul's house and was coming from her friends house in Chicago. Miss Viol was also complaining about a friend in Chicago that was going to commit suicide if she doesn't get back to Chicago within the hour. Miss Viol's behavior was erratic, could not stop talking, couldn't explain anything in depth and did not make sense. I asked Miss Viol if she suffers from any medical problems or ever diagnosed with anything. Miss Viol stated she has OCD and Manic Depression Anxiety Disorder which she does not take medication for. Lt. Hunt and P.O. Stewart arrived on scene shortly after. While speaking with Miss Viol she could not stop texting people on her phone and was saying she was texting her friends. Miss Viol stated if she stop's texting her friends that she will commit suicide and she doesn't want her friend to die. After speaking with Miss Viol for several minutes it was determined that she had split personalities and was speaking with Saul in which she complied. I identified myself and Saul stated that he was with the police at his residence in Walden NY and stated he would put the officer on the phone. I spoke to P.O. Adam Watt #47 Village of Walden Police Department in NY. P.O. Watt stated he was at Saul Alvarez's residence to take a missing/endangered person's report for Miss Viol. P.O. Watt stated that Mr. Alvarez was concerned for her welfare because she was sending him numerous amounts of erratic text messages. I exchanged information with P.O. Watt and advised I would be getting Miss Viol evaluated by a hospital. P.O. Watt provided me with case #18-4700. I explained to Miss Viol that an ambulance was going to respond to get her treatment at a hospital. Miss Viol was pleased and thanked me but was very concerned for the welfare of her cat. I advised her I would take care of the cat. Miss Viol stated if the cat is not taken care of in the next hour her friend in Chicago is going to commit suicide. Mahwah EMS was dispatched and responded. Mahwah EMS and P.O. Stewart transported Miss Viol to New Bridge Medical Center. Miss Viol was taken into custody by New Bridge Medical Center and an involuntary Form was completed. Typo animal control was dispatched and responded and took custody of the Miss Viol's cat. John Caporusio from Typo advised the cat would be at the Paramus Animal Shelter. Cititwide Towing was dispatched and responded and took possession of the vehicle. An impound sheet was completed and signed by the tow. P.O. Stewart advised Miss Viol was transported without incident. All units clear.

INITIAL OBSERVATION:

On July 1, 2018, at approximately 10:34 hours, I was stationary on the shoulder of Interstate 287 South just south of the New York State line monitoring the southbound flow of traffic. Visibility was clear and traffic was flowing at medium volume. I was operating marked PSU Truck 111 and was in full Class-B uniform at the time of incident.

While monitoring traffic my attention was drawn to a white van approaching my location in the #2 lane of the highway. The vehicle seemed to slow its pace upon its approach. As it passed I noticed the driver appeared rigid with his arms locked at the "10 & 2" position. The passenger front window was down at the time. Through my training and experience as a police officer I believed the aforementioned to be a nervous reaction by a party upon observing my patrol vehicle.

At this time I departed from my location onto the shoulder and also began to travel south. As I did so the vehicle immediately moved into the #1 lane of the highway. Based on the aforementioned I believed the driver was monitoring my location. The vehicle continued onto State Route 17 South in the #1 lane of travel. At one point, as I was approaching in the #2 lane, the vehicle began to move into the #2 lane, but quickly moved back into the #1. I subsequently moved in behind the vehicle, a commercial van from Majestic Cleaning, which bore New York registration 68291ME.

MOTOR VEHICLE STOP:

The vehicle continued south in the #1 lane failing to keep right. As we approached the MacArthur Boulevard overpass I activated my emergency equipment signaling the vehicle to stop. The vehicle moved to the right and came to a stop on the shoulder of the highway shortly thereafter.

I approached the vehicle from the passenger side and was surprised by a female party seating in the passenger seat. Her seat was reclined keeping her out of view. At this time I requested the driver's license, registration, and proof of insurance. He was also informed of the reason for the stop. A male party was also seated among some tools behind the driver in the cargo area of the van. As I stood at the passenger door I could see multiple large plastic bags among the tools. Protruding from many of the bags were fireworks. The driver, JOSHUA REQUENA, presented a Pennsylvania driver's license identifying him as the same. According to REQUENA they were headed back from working in Pennsylvania. Subsequent to my request identification was provided by the front passenger, Shawna L. Coltrane, and the rear passenger, FRITZ B. PIERRE-LOUIS. At this time I returned to my vehicle to conduct a check of the requested items.

While checking the items provided I also requested Lt. Cherven respond to the scene. Subsequent to my check I approached the driver's side of the vehicle and requested REQUENA exit. He did so and we spoke near the front of my vehicle. REQUENA now informed me he was currently on parole for a possession of a firearm in Long Island, New York. According to REQUENA they were coming from Homestead, Pennsylvania where they had done carpet cleaning at the Wayne Hotel. He was given a pat down for weapons which yielded negative results.

Upon Lt. Cherven arriving on scene Ms. Coltrane and PIERRE-LOUIS were asked to exit as well. Ms. Coltrane informed me she had only taken a ride and was not responsible for any of the fireworks in the vehicle. According to PIERRE-LOUIS they had traveled to Pennsylvania this morning to purchase fireworks. PIERRE-LOUIS was also given a pat down for weapons which yielded negative results. As I was doing so he informed me that he is currently on probation supervised by the United States government stemming from a narcotics case.

At this time all three parties were asked to remain with Lt. Cherven while I removed the fireworks from the vehicle. I removed multiple bags and boxes. While doing so I took note of the large quantity and the fact that they were mainly airborne fireworks. All three parties were advised of their rights as per Miranda at this time to which they all stated they understood. Both REQUENA and PIERRE-LOUIS informed me that Ms. Coltrane was not responsible for the fireworks. They fireworks seized from the vehicle were loaded into vehicles 132 and 111. P.O. Connington arrived on scene and provided Ms. Coltrane with transportation to the Ramsey train station. I subsequently placed PIERRE-LOUIS under arrest and secured him in the rear of 111. I then placed REQUENA under arrest and Lt. Cherven secured him in vehicle 132. At REQUENA'S request the vehicle was secured at the scene. Both parties were then transported to police headquarters.

PROCESSING:

Upon our arrival at police headquarters both parties were secured in the holding cell and processed according to department regulations. The seized items were placed in Interview Room #1 at which time I inventoried them as the following:

Both REQUENA and PIERRE-LOUIS were photographed via MPD Digital Camera #1 as were the seized items. A complaint summons was prepared for each party by Lt. Cherven charging them with 21-3-2 (Possession of Fireworks). Both were provided with notices to appear in Central Judicial Processing court at 08:30 hours on July 20, 2018 in Hackensack, New Jersey. REQUENA identified his New York State Parole Officer as "Brennan", but could not provide any contact information. PIERRE-LOUIS identified his Federal probation officer as Andrew Jingeleski. I attempted contact with him at [REDACTED], however was only able to leave a voicemail. Both parties were released from custody at 14:20 hours. I provided REQUENA with transportation to retrieve his vehicle at that time. Lt. Cherven contacted the Bergen County Sheriff's Office regarding the seized items as well as D/Lt. Bussirelli. It was determined a representative from the Sheriff's Office Bomb Squad would respond the following day to take custody of the evidence with D/Lt. Bussirelli as the point of contact.

On 07/01/2018, Ofc. Lange and I responded to the above location on a report of water damage to the residence. Upon arrival, Ofc. Lange and I spoke with the resident, Robert Hermansen, who reported the water hose connected to the front of his house was left on sometime during the overnight hours.

Hermansen reported that he went away for the weekend from 06/29/2018 until 0045 hours on 07/01/2018. Hermansen reported during that time, he was confident the hose was turned off and not leaking. Hermansen reported that when he returned home at 0045 hours on 07/01/2018, he was alerted by his wife and daughter that there was water in the basement and the hose connected to the front of the house was on. Hermansen reported, he then went and checked to see if the water was turned on to the hose. Hermansen reported he discovered that the hose was in fact turned on and was placed into a hole, causing the water to flood the mulch to the front of the residence. Hermansen reported that there was not a hole in his mulch prior to him discovering the hose placed into the hole. Hermansen was adamant to officers that he believed this act was done intentionally in order to damage his property and flood his basement.

I asked Hermansen if any property in the basement was damaged, to which he responded by saying only a cardboard box was wet and he did not discover anything damaged due to the water. Hermansen believed the water was only turned on a short time prior to him returning home due to the fact that he did not discover abundant water damage to the basement or to the mulch in front of his residence.

While speaking with Hermansen, he expressed that he believed this act was done intentionally by his political rivals. I then asked if he had any proof to corroborate his belief to which he responded by saying he did not.

I asked Hermansen if he had any cameras to his residence that may have recorded anyone on his property earlier in the evening to which he responded by saying he did not. Hermansen was advised he may want to get cameras to the exterior of his home for his own peace of mind in the future. Hermansen agreed and stated he will be purchasing cameras for the safety of his family.

Ofc. Lange and I then checked to see if his neighbors had any cameras to their homes with negative results.

Hermansen was advised this incident would be documented and we would inform the day tour supervisor of the incident in an effort to increase patrols on his street.

I advised Hermansen to contact the police if he should find any damage to property throughout the day so it could be documented.
