On July 4, 2018 at 1210 hours, I, Ptl. Charles Henry and Ptl. Joseph Mason were dispatched to 34 Daniel Drive for an escort. Upon arrival, we met [REDACTED] who requested that we escort them to their residence to gather their belongings. While we were speaking with them, their father Drew Kowalsky came outside the residence. Drew reported that [REDACTED] were arrested for shoplifting two days ago and were grounded. He advised that while they were grounded, they snuck out of the house and stayed at the neighbor's house. He stated that he knew the girls were at the neighbor's house so he did not file a report with the Police or attempt to locate them. Drew also reported that their mother has been in Turkey and does not know when she intends on coming back to the United States.

The children reported that they attempted to come back home late at night but the front door was locked. They advised that they contacted their mother, Carol Jimenez and told her that they were locked out of the house. Jimenez contacted her friend, Kasey Canbay and asked her to pick the children up. Canbay reported that she was informed that the children were locked out of their house and needed a place to stay. Canbay advised that she was unaware that their father wanted them to stay at his house.

Drew reported that [REDACTED] were also caught attempting to buy cigarettes online and attempting to steal beer at a party recently. He was advised that a report would be completed and that the Division of Child Protection and Permanency would be advised of the incident. He was also advised that DCPD would most likely respond to his residence to conduct a follow up within the next several days.

I contacted Jennifer #1369 of DCPD who advised that a child welfare assessment would be conducted within 72 hours. She reported that a member of the Monmouth North Office would be responding.

On July 4, 2018 shortly before 1657 hours, I, Ptl. Charles Henry, was in patrol vehicle 220 observing traffic on Main Street. I observed a silver Mercury sedan bearing NJ Reg: S87KAK traveling on Main Street southbound. I observed that the vehicle did not have a front license plate mounted on the front bumper. I turned onto Main Street southbound and continued to the Main Street and SH 34 intersection. There was multiple vehicles between my patrol vehicle and the suspect vehicle on Main Street. I followed the vehicle onto SH 34 southbound. The vehicle stopped at the red light at the intersection of SH 34 and Broad Street. The suspect vehicle was in the right lane and my vehicle was in the left lane. I stopped my patrol vehicle just behind the stop line and the suspect vehicle stopped approximately 7 feet behind the stop line. When I looked at the suspect vehicle, I observed the driver later identified as, Kerolos Suryil and the passenger later identified as Magdy Samaan, speaking to each other. While they were talking, they were looking straight ahead and did not look at each other once.

When the traffic light turned green, I remained at the stop line for approximately 30 seconds in an attempt to let the suspect vehicle go in front of me so I could conduct a motor vehicle stop. I was forced to begin to travel southbound first to avoid obstructing traffic any further. As soon as I began to accelerate, the suspect vehicle accelerated as well. I observed the vehicle make a sudden right turn into the parking lot of the Shoppes at Matawan parking lot. I turned left into the parking lot of a vacant business and watched the suspect vehicle pull into a parking space in front of Wine Nation. No one exited the vehicle once parked and the vehicle quickly backed out. The vehicle exited the parking lot and began to travel southbound on SH 34 again. I believed the driver of the vehicle pulled into the parking lot and exited quickly in an attempt to avoid being stopped. I turned onto SH 34 southbound and stopped the vehicle on SH 34 near CPC.

I approached the vehicle from the passenger side and requested Suryil to provide me with his driver's license, registration, and proof of insurance. When Suryil was handing the documents to me, I observed his hand shaking excessively. Suryil reported that he was coming home from work and looking for a pizzeria that was open. I went back to my patrol vehicle and began to check Suryil's driver's license. I asked County Dispatch to check Suryil for active warrants and for criminal history. Ptl. Joseph Mason arrived on scene and I advised him of the nervous behavior and suspicious course of driving. Ptl. Mason approached the vehicle and spoke with the occupants. Dispatch advised me that Suryil did not have any active warrants but had criminal history including narcotics offenses.

I asked the Suryil to exit the vehicle to speak with me. Suryil reported that

they were working on a construction site in Toms River and wanted to stop at a Pizzeria on the way home. He advised that the pizzeria they normally go to was closed. Suryil lives in Middletown and the Samaan lives in Keansburg. Suryil reported that he stopped at the Shoppes at Matawan looking for a pizzeria or place to eat. I advised Suryil of the suspicious behavior that I observed. When I asked Suryil why he traveled in the opposite direction of his residence looking for a pizzeria and why he was in Matawan, he stated because he goes to Church on SH 34. I asked Suryil if there was anything illegal in the vehicle and he said no. I asked Suryil if he would consent to a search of the vehicle and he said yes. I advised Suryil that he had the right to refuse the consent to search the vehicle and had the right to stop the search at any time. Suryil advised that he would still consent to the search.

Ptl. Mason had his K9 Blade conduct and exterior sniff of the vehicle. Ptl. Mason advised me that Blade indicated the presence of narcotics in the trunk area and front passenger door. A search of the vehicle was conducted and the following items were seized: 1 orange straw that had a white powdery substance residue, 1 empty wax fold, and 3 rubber bands commonly used for packaging heroin. The straw and two rubber bands were found in the front passenger area where Blade indicated. 1 rubber band was found in the trunk of the vehicle and the empty wax fold was underneath the driver seat. There were small pieces of Chore Boy spread out on the driver side floor near the driver's seat.

When Samaan was searched incident to arrest, two rolled up bills (\$1 and \$20) that had a white powdery substance residue was found in his wallet. I transported Suryil and Samaan to Police Headquarters to be processed. Both subjects were released on a summons for possession of paraphernalia (1339-S-2018-000270, 1339-S-2018-000271). Suryil was also issued a motor vehicle summons for improper display of license plates (1339-E18-001899).

On 7/4/18, I assisted Ptl. Henry #136 on a motor vehicle stop (see 18MW05075). While on scene, Ptl. Henry advised that the driver, identified as Kerolos Suryil, gave consent to search his vehicle. I then spoke with Suryil and advised him that I would be deploying my narcotics K9. I further asked if there was anything in the vehicle that could harm my K9, to which he advised there was not. I then conducted a safety check around the vehicle which yielded negative results. I then retrieved K9 Blade from my patrol vehicle for a narcotics search.

K9 Blade is a 2 year old, Belgian Malinois that is certified in narcotics detection. K9 Blade was brought to the front passenger headlight of the vehicle on a six foot lead and given his start command of "sniff it out." It was at this time that a counter clockwise pattern was conducted around the exterior. Upon reaching the rear passenger tail light, K9 Blade displayed a head spin and returned to the trunk handle. While at the trunk handle, K9 Blade took several closed-mouth, deep rapid sniffs, all indications of my K9 being in the presence of a narcotic odor. K9 Blade then stood on his hind legs and casted his nose directly above the trunk, ultimately placing his nose at the right trunk seam. While at the seam, K9 Blade's body became completely rigid and he turned to look at me. K9 Blade then placed his nose at the seam and began scratching, which is his indication at source of a narcotic odor. K9 Blade was told "good boy" and continued to search. Upon reaching the front, open passenger window, K9 Blade casted high and placed his head in the car. K9 Blade then worked from seam to seam on his hind legs while in the window. While doing so, he took several closed-mouth, deep rapid sniffs. K9 Blade then became completely rigid, looked back at me, and then scratched at the dashboard, all indications of him being in the presence of a narcotic odor. K9 Blade was praised and returned to my patrol vehicle.

A hand search of the vehicle was conducted (see Ptl. Henry's report for further information).

Suspected CDS paraphernalia was located in the trunk as well as the passenger compartment of the vehicle. Ptl. Henry requested I utilize K9 Blade inside of the vehicle after all contraband was removed. K9 Blade was again brought to the vehicle and conducted an interior search. K9 Blade indicated on the passenger floor by scratching at it. Ptl. Henry advised that CDS paraphernalia was located there. A search of the remainder of the vehicle yielded negative results.

On July 4, 2018 at approximately 2016 hrs Sgt. O'Boyle #120, Ptl. Brooks #137, Ptl. Ramcheran #140 and I, Ptl. While waiting to pay, he observed a light skin black male approximately 5'7 wearing a white shirt walking towards the cashier screaming "fuck you white people, I have a gun". The suspect continued to scream at the employees and other customers and yelled that no one was leaving until the video tape is reviewed.
