Suarez advised he was involved in a dispute with his ex-girlfriend, Cynthia Vallecillo, earlier on today's date. Prior to the altercation, Vallecillo began receiving numerous phone calls from a friend. Suarez indicated he became annoyed with constant interruptions so he grabbed the phone from her. An argument then ensued. During the altercation, Suarez observed Vallecillo remove a small canister of pepper spray from her purse. He then attempted to "wrestle" it away from her, however the spray was activated striking both Vallecillo and Suarez. Shortly after, Suarez contacted police.

I then spoke with Vallecillo who confirmed the argument originated over phone calls she received from a friend. During the altercation, Vallecillo became fearful after Suarez continued approaching her while yelling and screaming. She claimed she only grabbed the pepper as a precautionary measure to defend herself. She also indicated the pepper spray was activated as a result of Suarez attempting to gain control of it.

Both parties were subjected to the effects of the pepper spray, however neither had visible signs of injury. Suarez did not request side by side service. He did not want to sign complaints or apply for a TRO. Both were evaluated by CHEMS, however they refused care. Suarez left the area while Vallecillo returned to her residence without further incident.

Cherry Hill Police Communications received a call from the Camden County Alarm Room (county fire and EMS dispatch). Dispatch advised police that the Cherry Hill Fire Department and EMS were both being dispatched to 1517 Berlin Road for a report of a vehicle into a house. Dispatcher Lendahl, confirmed the address with the county dispatcher, as it was the same as she had received a 911 hang up from. PO Paul Holodnak (394) was the first officer to arrive to the scene along with the CHFD and EMS.

A black Mazda 3 bearing NJ D46DEW (Vehicle 2), had entered the residence at 1517 Berlin Road through the east wall of the home. The vehicle was stopped completely inside the building, however the driver was uninjured and out of the car. All the residents of the home were also uninjured from the crash. The county dispatchers had also received reports that a second vehicle was involved in the collision and was identified as a blue Ford Mustang that fled the scene after the crash. Those reports were confirmed by the driver of Vehicle 2. PO Eric Holloway (302) heard the transmission of the second involved vehicle and located a blue Ford Mustang parked on the lot of TD Bank (1506 Berlin Road) at approximately 0903 hours. The car was backed into a spot facing west on the east side of the lot. The vehicle was bearing NJ UUB59X (Vehicle 1). Upon speaking with the driver, Officer Holloway advised that the driver confirmed he was involved in the collision. He was also uninjured from the incident.

I was detailed to the location for the investigation.

Scene:

Haddonfield-Berlin Road is a four lane county highway designated as CR 561. There are two eastbound and two westbound lanes that are separated by a double solid yellow stripe. The individual lanes are about 12 feet wide. In the area of the collision it is just after the rise of the roadway and slopes gradually down to the west. On the eastbound side of the road I located two impact marks on the curb in front of 1523 Berlin Road. The first impact was just east of the driveway. The second strike was to the west of the driveway at 1521 Berlin Road. Vehicle 2 continued across the grass and over the sidewalk. It crossed over the driveway at 1521, leaving tire marks showing the vehicle was rotating. The vehicle then slid across the front lawn of 1521 continuing to rotate and crossed over the township sidewalk that leads further into the adjoining neighborhood (land parcel denoted as 1519). As the vehicle crossed the property line of 1517 it began to straighten out and entered the east side of the home. This load bearing wall was completely smashed in and Vehicle 2 was stopped inside a converted garage area. The roof of the structure had begun to collapse in this room. The force of the impact had buckled the front wall of the home.

In the roadway I identified two fresh parallel tire marks consistent with those from locked wheels. The marks were on the westbound side of the roadway straddling the westbound lanes. The left mark began in the area in front of 1527 Berlin Road and was approximately 350 feet in length. The second mark was to the right of the divider line and began in the area of 1524 Berlin Road and was 240 feet in length. Both marks ended in front of 1518. At the end of the marks, they did not get heavy, as would be expected from a vehicle that comes to a complete stop, but they lightened up, as when a driver releases the brakes and continues forward. Both marks were uniform, except for one portion of the first mark. Just prior to the onset of the second mark, the left mark was darker towards the inside of the mark and was incomplete toward the outer left edge. This would indicate that the vehicle was impacting something from the left side, shifting the weight to the inside of the tire. The weight shift ends roughly where the second mark then begins. This weight shift denotes the area of the contact between the vehicles in the roadway. On the grass in front of 1524 Berlin Road, I located a blue metallic cosmetic scoop. This scoop had minor chipping on the leading edge, as if it were ripped backwards off a vehicle. There was no other damage to this piece.

I spoke to the operator of Vehicle 2. He initially reported that he was traveling west on Berlin Road in the left (inside) lane. He approximated his speed to be 40 to 45 miles per hour, when a blue Ford Mustang approached from the rear and contacted his vehicle sending it spinning across the highway. His vehicle came to rest inside the home. When I reviewed the initial scene evidence and the current location of his vehicle, with him, he indicated that his speed was possibly in the range of 60 to 65 miles per hour.

I responded to the lot of the TD Bank where I met with the operator of Vehicle 1. His car was parked in the east side of the lot backed into a stall facing west. It was parked with the right side of the vehicle over the marker for the stall next to it, taking up two spaces. Upon visual inspection of the vehicle, there was minimal damage. There were a few scuffs on the driver's side of the vehicle going from the front to the rear. A cosmetic scoop on the driver's side of the vehicle was also missing. On the front edge of the driver's side door there was a dent to the vehicle's body. The dented area was pushed in while the vehicle was going forward as the dent is also slanted to the rear. The front wheels of the vehicle were turned out making the tread visible to me as I walked around the vehicle. The unique pattern on the tread of the tire matched that of the fresh marks that were on the roadway. There was also a broken piece of the front left undercarriage, near the arm of the left front tire, hanging down toward the pavement. Driver 1 indicated he was traveling west on Berlin Road at approximately 40 miles per hour in the right (outside) lane. As he cleared the intersection with Cranford Road, he observed Vehicle 2 in the left lane. According to Driver 1, while overtaking the vehicle, at 40 miles per hour, Vehicle 2 inexplicably left its lane and struck the side of his vehicle. From the impact, Vehicle 2 went across the roadway. He continued to drive east after impact but lost steering in his vehicle, so he pulled onto the lot of TD Bank. I inquired as to what part of his vehicle was struck by Vehicle 2 and he pointed to the dent. He made no reference to the other damage at first. Then he indicated that his driver's side mirror was also knocked back. There was no damage to the passenger side of the vehicle. When informed that the damage appeared side swipe damage he indicated that it must have been from the side impact. He also advised that his car never made contact with the curb on the passenger's side. When I advised him that the other driver indicated he was traveling at 60 to 65 miles per hour, he indicated that he thought it was 40 to 45 but may have been "a little faster."

Cioffi's Tow service responded to the residence and removed Vehicle 2 from the structure. I was able to inspect the exterior of the vehicle for damage. There was heavy damage on the vehicle from the contact with the house obscuring any marks that would have been visible from contact with another vehicle. Both right side rims were bent. These two wheels impacted the curb on Berlin Road prior to Vehicle 2 leaving the roadway. The force of the impact with the curb bent the metal rims. This initial contact with the curb was not sufficient to stop the momentum of Vehicle 2 as it continued west. It rotated across the concrete and grass of two properties along with the extended driveway of 1517 and still carried enough momentum that when it struck the load bearing wall of the home, it penetrated it. The vehicle then completely entered the structure before to come to a complete stop.

From the evidence left on the roadway I was able to calculate a minimum speed for a slide to stop. The one long tire mark (tire mark on the left side), was left initially by the front left wheel of Vehicle 1. For an unknown reason something in the front left wheel broke causing this tire to lock. This mark was 110 feet in length. During the time this wheel was locked contact was made with Vehicle 2. The driver of Vehicle 1 then applied the brakes causing the remaining 240 feet of tire marks. With this data I calculated a minimum speed for a slide to stop at 72 miles per hour*. This is not the actual speed that Vehicle 1 was traveling however, as this calculates the speed had Vehicle 1 come to a complete stop. From the marks on the road the vehicle did not stop, but rather continued to travel west. Using the same combined speed formula I calculated a minimum speed for Vehicle 2. Utilizing the distances measured over the different surfaces that Vehicle 2 crossed I calculated a minimum speed to be 68 miles per hour*. The distance I used for the final leg of the measurement stopped at the side of the residence. Due to the structural integrity of the house being severely compromised, I calculated the speed as if Vehicle 2 had stopped at the wall of the home. However the vehicle was carrying more speed than I was able to calculate, as it actually broke through into the home.

Camden County Communications provided me with all calls they received from 911 or their seven digit line about the incident. One caller, Jonathan Nisula (215-595-6152) reported that the crash occurred around two to three minutes prior to him contacting police. The call log time stamped his call at 0854 hours. The operator of Vehicle 2 was able to get out of the vehicle and was on the front lawn of the home, as the homeowner notified police. The operator of Vehicle 1 drove from the scene and backed into a marked stall. He made no attempt to contact police to advise that he had been involved in a crash. Mr. Nisula indicated that the blue Mustang (Vehicle 1), after striking Vehicle 2 fled the scene at a high rate of speed. Vehicle 1 was located at 0903 by PO Holloway, with a minimum of ten minutes passing after the crash. The call was put out as a priority call, with response from CHPD, CHFD, CHEMS and Virtua Medics all responding to the scene with lights and sirens. At no time did Driver 1 make any attempt to flag down any responding vehicle to alert them to his involvement. He was in possession of a cell phone, that he used to contact a private tow company for his vehicle and contact his mother, but he did not call 911. He did not even walk to the roadway to flag down any officers that were attempting to find a blue Mustang that fled the scene. Only upon inquiry by PO Holloway did the driver respond that he was involved.

The Cherry Hill Building Inspector, Bill Cattrel, responded to the location and deemed the structure unsafe. American Red Cross were notified and personnel responded to help place the family in temporary housing. All photographs of the incident as well as the audio from all calls to both county and Cherry Hill Dispatch centers were uploaded to the secure Traffic Safety server.

Description of Incident:

Vehicle 2 was traveling west on Berlin Road in the inside (left) lane, at a high rate of speed. Vehicle 1 was also traveling west on Berlin Road in the inside lane at a high rate of speed behind Vehicle 2. After crossing through the intersection of Cranford Road, Driver 1 attempted to pass Vehicle 2. He began to move his vehicle into the right (outside) lane and accelerate. As he closed in on Vehicle 2, the driver's side of his vehicle contacted the rear passenger's side of Vehicle 2. From this contact, Vehicle 2 began to rotate counter clockwise and crossed the center line. The passenger's side of the vehicle contacted the curb, overrode the curb and left the roadway. It continued to rotate as it crossed the properties of 1523 and 1521 Berlin Road. It then crossed the driveway of 1517 Berlin Road and contacted the side of the home. It came to rest inside the east wall of the residence.
