Dear Sir, Madam,

The Township of Harrison received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on February 4, 2020. The official Records Custodian, Diane Malloy, received your OPRA request on February 4, 2020. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is February 13, 2020. This response to your request is being provided to you on the [6th] business day after receipt of said request.

The following information is being provided and will be considered responsive to your request:

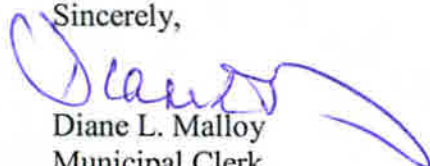
Attached are the CAD lists for the dates requested. On January 22, there were 96 CADs generated and on January 31, there were 128 CADs generated. We will be happy to provide you with specific CADs and narratives, however, there are a total of 224 CADs that will need to be looked at individually and evaluated to determine which are able to be released as per your request. If you wish for us to go through all the CADs and evaluate them and make the necessary redactions, this will involve an extraordinary amount of hours to gather and prepare the documents and as such, OPRA allows for a special service fee to be charged. If you want to do this, we would also require a time extension to provide the documents. An alternate option, if you prefer, is to let us know specifically which CADs you are interested in based off the attached lists, we will evaluate those on a case by case basis.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Township of Harrison to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form.

You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
