Dear Sir/Madam:

The Evesham Township Clerk's Office received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on **April 22, 2020**. The Evesham Township Police Department Records Custodian received your OPRA request on **April 22, 2020**. The seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is **May 1, 2020**. This response to your request is being provided to you on the **1st** business day after the custodian's receipt of said request.

Your OPRA request sought access to the following: *"1. All police CAD reports with narratives for the days of 12-26-2018, 3-10-2019, 3-11-2019..."*. **Your OPRA request may result in over 800 incident reports with well over 1600 pages.**

At this time, we request clarification of your OPRA request. **Please respond to this email to clarify if there is any specific party, location, type of incident or other that could assist in the narrowing of this request or if you wish to have the request proceed in full. Failure to provide clarification of your request by the deadline date of May 1, 2020 will result in the closure of this OPRA request.** You may submit another OPRA request at any time.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Evesham Township Police Department to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
