On Wednesday, December 26, 2018 at approximately 1547 hours, I responded priority two via patrol vehicle 1602 to the Walmart located at 150 East Route 70 on report that a black male shoplifted from the business and fled in a vehicle. While I was responding to the store, Officer Divito advised via police radio that he was conducting a stop on the potential suspect vehicle. Upon my arrival, I spoke to the caller, Walmart loss prevention employee Tracey Hoffman.

According to Tracey, she confronted a black male at the exit door after he concealed merchandise inside a backpack that he selected from the store. The male was also pushing a cart which contained merchandise that was reportedly unpaid for. The male fled on foot after being confronted by Hoffman and he abandoned the cart but left with the backpack. Further investigation found that the male utilized the self checkout and used the tag of roses to give the illusion that he was ringing items up.

While I was reviewing surveillance footage with Tracey, I established phone contact with Sgt. Short who was on the vehicle stop with Officer Divito. I provided Sgt. Short with a description of the suspect and he informed me that Officer Divito took the male suspect into custody after he made an admission.

I advised Hoffman that she would need to respond to police headquarters to sign a complaint against the male. Tracey advised that she would do such and I responded to police headquarters. While at the station, I spoke to Officer Divito in the cell block and I took over possession of the stolen backpack. I returned the item to Hoffman while we were inside interview room number one and an inspection of such found that the backpack had a value of \$24.88. Further investigation found that the stolen backpack contained wrangler jeans value at \$19.97, a \$1.00 bandana, pajamas valued at \$11.96 and hair ties which had a value of \$3.88. That amount totaled \$61.69 and Hoffman advised that the cart that the male abandoned after she confronted him contained \$101.17 worth of unpaid for merchandise. As a result, the total amount for this case was found to be \$162.86.

While the male suspect, who was identified as Jarvis Dutch, remained in the cell block, I typed criminal complaint summons S-2018-0313-934 which charged him with violating shoplifting, 2C:20-11B(1), a disorderly persons offense. I also had Hoffman complete a probable cause statement. After I printed out the complaint summons, Hoffman signed the documents after I read such to her. After signing the complaint, Hoffman left the station after she turned 2 receipts and a store video DVD-R over to me. I also had her sign the back of a property form before she left which indicated that I turned the stolen backpack and the items that were concealed inside over to her (SK-1).

Dutch was released after he was given a ROR form in regards to unrelated Cherry Hill ACS warrant S 2016 002557. Officer Divito advised me that he successfully executed that warrant and prior to releasing Jarvis I advised him that Walmart signed a civilian criminal complaint against him for shoplifting. While at headquarters, I packaged the two receipts as item SK-3 and the DVD-R was held as SK-2. I placed the signed complaint as well as the signed probable cause statement in the court bin for probable cause finding. In addition to a property form, I completed a tracking slip, an arrest report and a victim notification form for this case. Jarvis was also photographed and fingerprinted prior to his release by Officers Divito and Schmidt.

On Wednesday December 26, 2018 at approx 15:47p WalMart loss prevention reported a shoplifting just occurred. A black male just left the store with merchandise that he didn't pay for. Once in the parking lot he enters a black Toyota and made a right turn on N. Locust Ave. When doing so the began heading to Ptl Bakely, who was on a motor vehicle stop on N. Locust Ave near N. Maple Ave. He observed a black Toyota Prius make a left turn into the neighborhood prior to reaching him. Loss prevention stated the black male got into the passenger seat and had short dread locks. The vehicle appeared to be operated by a light skin black male. I was operating my unmarked patrol vehicle, 1302, southbound on N. Maple Ave from Greentree Rd. As I approached Burgundy Dr I observed a black Toyota Prius pass me heading northbound on N. Maple Ave. I saw the vehicle was operated by a light skin black female and the passenger was a black male with short dreadlocks. I activated my emergency lights and made a u-turn at N. Maple Ave and Burgundy Dr. I notified dispatch of my location and that I would be stopping the vehicle in front of 135 N. Maple Ave.

I conducted a passenger side approach of the vehicle, introduced myself, and asked for identification from the passenger and driver. The driver provided a NJDL but the passenger stated that he didn't have his identification on him. He initially provided a name of Correy Morris, but later provided his correct name of Jarvis Dutch. While having a conversation with the occupants about why they were stopped, Dutch reached in the back seat and stated 'I'll just give them their stuff back if I can go home.' I asked him to put his hands back in the front and not to reach for anything. There was a black backpack on the backseat floor behind the driver. Walmart security stated he exited the store with a backpack containing merchandise. I asked Dutch to grab the backpack and give it to me, which he did. I then asked Dutch to exit the vehicle to speak with me. After doing so he was placed under arrest for shoplifting. I placed his hands behind his back, placed my department issued handcuffs on his wrists, double locked them, then conducted a search incident to arrest with negative findings. Dispatch was advised of 1 adult male in custody then I checked the rear seat of my patrol vehicle for contraband, with negative findings. Dutch was placed in the rear of my patrol car, secured with a seat belt, then taken to headquarters. While enroute casual conversation occurred between me and Dutch.

Once back at headquarters I pulled into the sally port, then closed the garage door. I placed my duty weapon in the department approved gunlocker in the sally port, then removed Dutch from the rear of 1302. A secondary search of the rear seat was conducted with negative findings. Dutch was then taken into the processing area from the sally port. Once in the processing room, I removed the handcuffs and outer coat. I conducted a secondary search of Dutch with negative results. Dutch was processed, fingerprinted, then placed in cell 1. a check of the cell showed no damage or contraband. His CCH was checked by Ptl Kennedy which stated no DNA was needed. Walmart loss prevention arrived and a statement of loss was completed. Any merchandis Dutch had was returned to Walmart personnel. An ACS warrant was located for Dutch out of Cherry Hill. Cherry Hill was contacted and a ROR was approved. all paperwork was completed, copied, and faxed. The warrant was executed. Dutch was given a copy of the ROR with a court date of 1-2-2019 at 0830a. Dutch was then processed and released. All arrest paperwork was completetd and submitted. There were no field notes for this investigation. The ATS warrant was executed in the system.

When I arrived location I made contact with the walk in, Laura Morris, in the lobby area and she stated she wanted to report a delayed shoplifting that had occurred. I directed Morris into interview room 1 and had her explain what occurred. Morris reported that she is the Director of Administration and on December 24, 2018 at approximately 12:22pm, a female subject had entered the store with a cart and a bag. The female selected items from liquor, cheese, seafood, meats, and meals to go. The female concealed the items in a bag in at 12:38pm in the produce department. The female further concealed items in her bag while at the cafe. The female then exited the store with no attempt to pay for the stolen items. Morris stated she followed the woman to a blue Nissan Rogue bearing NJ registration [REDACTED]. Morris stated she stood and watched the female offload the items into the vehicle and then approached the female and asked if she was done with the cart. Morris stated that the woman stated she was and left the area. Morris stated that the woman had dark hair, black sweat pants, black and gray sweatshirt, and appeared over weight with dark hair in her late 30s. Morris provided me with a thumb drive containing the photographs of the unknown female. Contained in the pictures on Morris cell phone was a photo that was detailed which identified the suspect's facial features and body structure. Morris reported that the woman stole over \$200.00 worth of items. Morris completed a Probable Cause Statement Form and I informed her that I would contact her if I was able to identify the shoplifter.

I entered the license plate provided by Morris into the [REDACTED]. I received information that the owner, Gregory Gorelik ([REDACTED]) was the registered owner. A look up further on the vehicle registration provided no other information in NEW WORLD. I then entered Gorelik's information into TLO and identified a phone number for Gorelik with 2 other residents that lived at the address. I observed that Laura Gorelik (wife) and another female, Yekaterin Boulin, lived at the residence. I contacted Gorelik by phone [REDACTED] and asked him about who was operating his vehicle on December 24, 2018 in the afternoon. Gorelik asked about why I was contacting him and asking him about his vehicle, I informed Gorelik that a witness observed a female in his vehicle during the commission of a crime. Gorelik then asked how serious the crime was and I informed him. Gorelik stated that his daughter, Yekaterin Boulin, was operating his vehicle on that day and routinely drives that car. I asked Gorelik for her information and he provided it but stated that Boulin was not home and that she was out. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] I was able to conclude through a photo of Boulin that she was the suspect and that Boulin also had 3 prior shoplifting's with a 4th pending prosecution by the prosecutors office. I contacted Morris by phone and informed her that I identified the suspect and she stated that she would be in sometime tomorrow to sign complaints.

I completed a Property Description Short Form, Case Tracking Slip, and a Victim Notification Form. I placed the evidence into locker 10 and had Sgt. Short review the materials. I then forwarded all information to my supervisor for review.

On December 26, 2018, at approximately 10:05 hours, I, Patrolman Gates, was dispatched to Walmart, 150 East Route 70, for a report of a male subject that exited the store without paying. I responded priority 2 in marked patrol vehicle 1603. Central communications then advised that the description of the suspicious person was a black male, approximately 6'5" in height, wearing a black beanie, sunglasses, and a heavy tan jacket. Upon arrival, I searched the parking lot for the description of the male, yielding negative results. I then met with Loss Prevention Associate, Tracy Hoffman, who stated she would review the camera footage of the male subject accused of shoplifting. I then spoke with the caller identified as Kandie Press, she stated she was paying for her items at the register when she noticed a black male wearing a tan jacket proceed past the point of sale with the shopping cart and the products. At the point of sale, the male was asked by an employer identified as, Sandra Cuthbert to show his receipt he stated he did not need to provide one and continued to leave the store. The male then left location in what appeared to be a dark colored, four door sedan.

After the incident, I made contact with Loss Prevention Associate, Tracy Hoffman who reviewed the camera footage and had specific times of when the male subject entered and exited the store. The male subject parked the vehicle in the parking lot at 0928, entered at 0930, and exited at 0950. Hoffman was able to determine the male stole approximately \$300.00 to \$400.00 worth of merchandise, however she was not able to provide a specific list of the items. Hoffman made a copy of the surveillance footage. I completed a property description form and the surveillance was submitted into evidence. [REDACTED] A victim notification form was completed. At this time the case is closed pending identification of the male.
