On March 10, 2019 while patrolling in the area of E. Route 70 and Cropwell I observed a blue 2-dr sedan [REDACTED] traveling near the TD Bank (336 W. Route 70) with a headlight out. At this time I proceeded to conduct a motor vehicle stop of the vehicle near the TD bank where I made contact with the driver of the vehicle, Brian Garvey, who stated that he was on his way home to his girlfriend's house [REDACTED]. At this time I was provided with all requested documents and I proceeded back to my vehicle. A check through P5 revealed the Garvey had an ATS warrant out of Deptford Twp. for the amount of \$405.00 (SPZ637182). At this time I proceeded back to the vehicle and advised Garvey to step outside where he was taken into custody. Garvey was handcuffed behind the back using the double lock method and escorted over to Patrol Vehicle #1601 where he was searched incident to arrest resulting with negative findings. Garvey was secured inside and transported to Police Headquarters without incident. A check of the rear prisoner compartment was conducted prior to transport for contraband resulting with negative findings. Brian's vehicle was left on location in the parking lot of the TD Bank, secured, and his girlfriend was contacted via telephone and advised to respond to the scene to pick up her [REDACTED] year old son who was seated in the front passenger seat of Brian's car. Upon her arrival she retrieved her child without incident and followed Police units to Police Headquarters.

Upon arrival to Police Headquarters I secured my firearm in the appropriate weapon receptacle and Garvey was taken out and escorted inside booking for processing. A check of the rear prisoner compartment was conducted for contraband resulting with negative findings. Brian was processed, photographed and an inventory conducted of all his property. Contact was made with Deptford Twp. Police where I was advised that he would be ROR'd (approval Sgt. Huffman) and was provided with a new court date. At this time Garvey signed an ROR form and was provided with his copy prior to turning him over to his girlfriend who was waiting at the station. At this time the signed ROR was faxed over to Deptford Twp. and an attempt to remove the warrant from AOC was made with no success due to the system currently being purged. No further action was taken and I cleared.
