On March 11, 2019 at approximately 1953 hours, police communications received a phone call regarding individuals possibly smoking narcotics in a vehicle in the area of [REDACTED]. The vehicle was described as a white SUV bearing NJ registration [REDACTED]. The caller last saw the vehicle driving towards the dead end road of Kenton Avenue near Kevin Way. I arrived in the area and observed the vehicle, a 2015 white Ford Escape, NJ registration [REDACTED] parked near the dead end of Kenton Avenue facing the wooded area occupied three times.

I activated my emergency lights and conducted a stop of the vehicle and made contact with the driver, identified as Dylan Cameron. I asked Cameron to provide his driving documents. While Cameron was retrieving his documents, he appeared to be nervous talking very low and shaking while handing over his paperwork. I confirmed that Cameron was not from the area and asked him what he was doing on Knightswood. He responded that him and his friends, later identified as [REDACTED] (front seat passenger) and Jonathan Fine (rear seat passenger), were sitting in the vehicle looking for something to do. I returned to my vehicle to check Cameron's paperwork and wait for an assisting unit so I could remove Cameron from the vehicle and speak with him away from everyone else in the vehicle.

Cpl. Bourdon #87 arrived at the stop location and I asked Cameron to step out of the vehicle which he did without incident. Cameron explained his story again and that Fine lives at [REDACTED] and said he was there to pick Fine up but Fine was at Wawa. I advised Cameron that a witness observed narcotics in the vehicle and explained to him the reason for the stop. Cameron admitted that he had marijuana in the vehicle in a black and red string bag as well as a metal grinder used to prepare marijuana.

Cameron was placed into handcuffs, doubled locked, and conducted a probable cause search of Cameron. He was detained in the rear of my patrol vehicle which was checked and clear of contraband. Ptl Weitzman #139 and Cpl. Bourdon #87 removed Fine and [REDACTED] from the vehicle and sat them on a nearby curb. Cameron told me where the marijuana could be found in the vehicle and he checked negative for any contraband on his persons. The rear of my patrol vehicle checked negative prior to and after the transport of Cameron to police headquarters. I conducted a probable cause search of the vehicle and located a clear zip lock bag further containing a greenish brown vegetation. I also located a metal grinder that contained marijuana and had a picture of Bob Marley on the cap. Cameron admitted to both items being his and he was unsure if any of the other occupants in the vehicle had any contraband in their possession.

I asked Fine if he had any contraband on his persons and advised him that he was going to be searched. Fine admitted to having two oil tubes that were THC as well as a vaping device. I retrieved the items from his right pants pocket and placed Fine into handcuffs, double locked, and Ptl. Weitzman placed Fine in the rear of his patrol vehicle.

[REDACTED] was then searched and checked negative for any contraband. Due to [REDACTED] being a juvenile, he contacted his mother, Joanne Widmaier; who came to the scene and took custody of [REDACTED]. Widmaier completed the juvenile release form and [REDACTED] was released to her care.

I transported Cameron to police headquarters without issue. Upon arrival my firearm was placed in the designated lockbox. Cameron was searched again, processed in booking and later released on a summons with a court date. Ptl. Weitzman transported Fine in his patrol vehicle and Fine was processed in booking as well and released on a summons with a court date. All of the evidence was seized in evidence locker number 13 at police headquarters and the suspected marijuana and THC was sent to the lab for testing. Nothing further to report.

On Monday, March 11, 2019, at 5:28 PM, I responded to police headquarters for a walk-in regarding harassing communication. I responded priority two in marked patrol vehicle 1801. Upon arrival, I met with [REDACTED] who I directed to interview room 2. [REDACTED] explained that last Tuesday, March 5, 2019, around 2:17 PM, he was contacted by user name Anand Anand Ji on Facebook. The person appeared to be a white woman. They ended up video chatting and [REDACTED] described the female as having undressed and coaxing him to get her excited. After about the sixth time of her asking him he ended up undressing from the waist down on video exposing his genitalia. The woman captured the video on recording and following the interaction ended up texting [REDACTED] and bribed him; wanting money or insisted they would share the video of him with his friends and family. [REDACTED] stated that he shared his phone number with the woman and they knew basic information about him from his Facebook account. [REDACTED] had all the text messages from the unknown woman on his phone and showed them to me. However, it should be noted that he completely deactivated his Facebook account and reported the user to Facebook prior to reporting this to police. In the messages the unknown person shared the names of his wife, cousin, sister-in-law and his wedding date with him. They also threatened to share the video on YouTube if [REDACTED] didn't pay them. If he paid them \$5000 then they would delete the video. They went back and forth quite a bit about paying and [REDACTED] stated that he didn't have that kind of money. Ultimately, he told them he only had \$20.00 cash in hand and his bank accounts were in the negative. The unknown person then insisted he pay \$100.00 now and then pay them more in the future to keep the video from going public. They were directing him to go to a Walgreen's or Fred Meyers. Fred Meyers is a grocery chain prominent on the West Coast, but has services such as Western Union within them that allow you to send and receive money internationally.

[REDACTED] never sent any money to the unknown party. However, they were attempting to make him pay up until this morning. Following this police report being made, [REDACTED] stated that he was going to block the number. While he was still at police headquarters, I attempted to locate the owner of the phone number, but it came back to a company that provides VoIP numbers to be, which are nearly impossible to track. Further, it should be noted that the way the unknown party wrote seems as if they are from another country. The date format they used was day-month-year and some of the words they used were unrecognizable to [REDACTED] or myself. [REDACTED] was provided with the case information and advised to update the police report should anything further come up. He was also provided with my work email address to screen shot the conversation and send to me. I later received the conversation and printed the images and placed them with the case tracking slip. This case is closed, as there is not enough investigative information to identify a suspect.

On Monday, March 11, 2019, at 10:38 AM, while at Police Headquarters, I was advised of a walk-in for harassment complaint. Upon checking the lobby, I met with Donna L. Worley of [REDACTED] who I escorted to interview room two. Worley advised she was having an ongoing neighbor dispute with the resident of [REDACTED] Alina El. Worley continued to state that the two have gone through mediation with the front office personnel of the complex they reside in, but it doesn't seem to help. The most recent incident was described to me. Worley stated that her [REDACTED] son [REDACTED] and when he walks about their apartment he steps loudly, which is unintentional. As he was walking about the apartment, Worley described hearing banging on the conjoined ceiling/floor of their apartments. She stated that this happens anytime there is even the slightest noise. This was followed up by an unknown female banging on her door and ringing her doorbell and stating that her grandson was asleep and to keep the noise down. Worley believed the woman to be El's mother or mother-in-law.

Worley acknowledged the quiet hours in the complex are from 11 PM through 7 AM, and there have been issues in the past with noise complaints at 5 AM, when she gets up to get ready for work. Further, she mentioned that this has escalated since El had her newborn recently and after El stopped getting her son on the bus for her over a year ago. Worley mentioned her son having said something to El and then she stopped putting her son on the bus for her, but she was unaware of the exact reason. I provided Worley with her options of requesting mediation through Evesham Municipal Court or to pursue a complaint. After she went back and forth about what to do she ultimately decided to pursue a harassment complaint against El. Worley completed a probable cause statement and then the complaint was generated; 0313-S-2019-000145. The potential court date, should Judge Karen Caplan find probable cause would be March 27, 2019, at 9:00 AM. Worley completed the complaint package with her signature on the certification line where required. Prior to Worley leaving, she inquired if contact would be made with El. I advised her that I would as long as she was requesting it. Worley wanted El informed of her report and possible complaint in hope that the issue stops. Worley then left headquarters.

I then contacted El via phone at 12:40 PM. She was caught off guard by my call and asked how I got her number. I advised her that Worley had it since she use to get her son on the bus in the mornings. I then advised her of the police report and possible complaint in progress should the Judge find probable cause to issue it. Worley then went on to tell me her version of what's been ongoing. El advised that they had been back and forth with the front office for mediation which instructed El to knock when she had an issue with Worley. She continued to state that she use to put Worley's son on the bus until he notified her that they had bed bugs in their apartment. El no longer wanted them at her residence due to the potential of bed bugs and this led to a falling out. El stated that noise was always an issue even before the falling out. El also advised that Worley and her son always run back and forth in their apartment and it's been more of an issue the last 4 months since having a newborn. She also acknowledged the quiet hours of the development and stated that
