The Borough of Glassboro Police Records Custodian received your request for records pursuant to the Open Public Records Act (OPRA), dated 8/28/22, via email on 8/30/22. Accordingly, the initial seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request under OPRA is 9/8/22. This response is being provided on the 1st business day after receipt of your request.

The following records were requested:

1. Police calls for service to 316 Overbrook Ave from 7/25/22 to 8/28/22.

A search of our available records has identified no records responsive to your request.

This response is being transmitted to you via email, as per your request. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5.b., the cost associated with this request is nothing.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Borough of Glassboro to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
