Suspect Information: Unknown suspect(s) at this time.

At approx. 1041 hrs. on 3/19/09 this officer responded to the area of 131 Beachtree Dr. in reference to a burglary to a motor vehicle. Upon arrival I spoke to the victim, [REDACTED] who stated that sometime after 2100 hrs. on 3/17/09 unknown suspect(s) entered [REDACTED] unlocked vehicle and removed approx. five dollars in coins from the vehicle.

The victim stated that when [REDACTED] exited [REDACTED] residence and entered [REDACTED] vehicle [REDACTED] observed a strong odor of a burnt cigarette inside the vehicle. The victim stated that [REDACTED] then observed the ashtray pulled out and all the change from inside the ashtray was missing except for the pennies. The victim stated that [REDACTED] did not report the incident yesterday due to time constraints and used the vehicle throughout the day resulting in the contamination of any crime scene evidence.
