On 10/25/2012 at approximately 0114 hrs, while investigating a Burglary at [REDACTED] Fox Glove Run (cross referenced case # [REDACTED]), an open window was discovered in the rear of the residence at 49 Fox Glove Run. The screen had been removed and it appeared that the unlocked window had been opened from the outside. Sgt. R. Maloney #223 and Ptl. J. Robertazzi #304 cleared the residence and also discovered that the front door was unlocked.

Upon making contact with the owner, [REDACTED] he advised that the residence is vacant while he makes repairs to it prior to a family member moving in. [REDACTED] inspected the residence and determined that nothing had been disturbed. [REDACTED] stated that he had left the rear kitchen window unlocked but that it was closed and the screen had been in place when he left. He also stated that the front door was locked.

Sheriff's Officer O'Hearn of the Ocean County Sheriff's Office CIU processed the scene. Ofc. O'Hearn discovered [REDACTED] on the [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Tire tracks, believed to be from a bicycle, run from the sidewalk in front of the residence to the backyard between 53 and 49 Fox Glove and then continue from the North side of the rear patio at 49 Fox Glove back to the sidewalk through the front yard of 45 Fox Glove at which time they are lost.

Multiple units canvassed the area, and Manchester Police were alerted to the incidents and that the suspect was believed to be riding a bicycle, with negative results. Nothing further at this time.
