On 7/29/19 at approximately 2300 hours, I, Ptl. M. Brown, was dispatched to 801 Dover Chase Blvd, for a report of a missing person. Upon arrival I met with reporting person [REDACTED] who related the following:

[REDACTED] lives with his brother [REDACTED] and has not seen him in a few days. [REDACTED] last saw [REDACTED] at the residence on Friday 7/26/19 at approximately 2000 hours; [REDACTED] was in the shower when [REDACTED] left to go grocery shopping, and at approximately 2200 hours when [REDACTED] returned home, [REDACTED] was no longer at the residence. [REDACTED] further advised that [REDACTED] does not have a car or a driver's license but has in the past left the residence unannounced for one or two days. During these absences, [REDACTED] is usually picked up by a friend and they both travel to a construction site to work. However, [REDACTED] explained that [REDACTED] is not usually gone this long, especially without calling his brother and disclosing his location. [REDACTED] has since reached out to all known coworkers of [REDACTED] and none have seen him.

I called all local hospitals and county jails which yielded negative results for [REDACTED]. According to [REDACTED] frequents the Tri City Plaza located at route 9 and route 70; a search of the area was conducted also yielding negative results. [REDACTED] is unsure if any clothing or belonging are missing from [REDACTED] bedroom. I attempted to contact [REDACTED] via his cell phone, however the phone call gets directly diverted to a voice mailbox, possibly indicating that the cell phone is turned off.

[REDACTED] was entered into NCIC as a missing person utilizing teletype 197. [REDACTED] was advised that if contact was made with [REDACTED] to immediately notify this agency.
