Dear Madam or Sir,

The Town of Secaucus received your November 21, 2022 e-mail request pursuant to the New Jersey Open Public Records Act ("OPRA") and the common law right of access. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is November 30, 2022. Please accept this letter as response to your request.

Your request seeks:

"All records that are connected to Police Case #20-01566 in the Year 2020."

As a threshold consideration, your request is improper. Under OPRA, a requestor must seek specific, identifiable documents or records. *MAG Entertainment, LLC v. Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control*, 375 N.J. Super. 534, 868 (App. Div. 2005). Your request for **"records that are connected to Police Case #20-01566 in the Year 2020"** a case is overly broad and fails to identify specific, identifiable record for the Town to provide. Accordingly, the Town is not under any obligation to respond to your request.

Nevertheless, without any waiver, there is no record information relating to your request.

As with any OPRA request, you have the right to challenge the decision by the Town. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council ("GRC") by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at PO Box 819, Trenton, NJ 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be
