The Town of Secaucus received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on January 10, 2024. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is January 19, 2024. Please accept this letter in response to your request.

Also, the total number of sworn law enforcement officers by bargaining unit(s).”

Regarding to: **“the total number of sworn law enforcement officers by bargaining unit(s).”** Currently, the total number of sworn law enforcement officers in the Secaucus Police department is 81.

mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
