THIS OFFICER (PTL. P.J. SMITH #12) OBSERVED A LIGHT BLUE COLORED FORD ESCORT BEARING NEW JERSEY REGISTRATION [REDACTED], PARKED IN A MARKED HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACE ON WEST RAILROAD AVENUE NEAR THE ENTRANCE TO P.N.C. BANK.

THIS OFFICER WAS TRAVELING SOUTH ON WEST RAILROAD AVENUE AND PASSED THE VEHICLE. A WHITE MALE LATER IDENTIFIED AS CRAIG PIPELING OF JAMESBURG WAS SITTING IN THE REAR DRIVERS SIDE PASSENGER SEAT SMOKING A CIGARETTE. THIS OFFICER DROVE APPROXIMATELY 100 FEET SOUTH AND TURNED AROUND TO APPROACH THE VEHICLE.

THIS OFFICER PULLED UP TO THE CAR AND SPOKE TO MR. PIPELING THROUGH THE WINDOW, AND ASKED IF THE DRIVER OR PASSENGERS WERE HANDICAPPED. HE INDICATED THAT THE DRIVER WAS NOT HANDICAPPED, AND THIS OFFICER COULD NOT SEE ANY PLACARD OR IDENTIFIER TO THE CONTRARY. THIS OFFICE THEN PULLED UP SEVERAL FEET AND STEPPED OUT OF THE PATROL CAR.

THIS OFFICER APPROACHED THE DRIVERS DOOR AND AGAIN SPOKE WITH MR. PIPELING. HE WAS ASKED IF THE DRIVER WAS AROUND. HE STATED THAT THEY WERE IN THE BANK. AND SHOULD ONLY BE A FEW MOMENTS LONGER. AT THIS TIME THIS OFFICER WAS STANDING FACING THE DRIVERS WINDOW IN THE STREET, AND OBSERVED IN PLAIN VIEW SEVERAL WAX PAPER FOLDS WITH A BLUE CIRCLE AND X ON THEM. THEY PACKED TOGETHER, AND Banded WITH A RUBBER BAND. I IMMEDIATELY RECOGNIZED IT TO BE DECKS OF HEROIN. THEY WERE PACKAGED INTO BUNDLES AND LAYING ON THE CENTER CONSOLE.

THIS OFFICER DID NOT INDICATE THE OBSERVATION TO MR. PIPELING, AND WAITED SEVERAL MOMENTS FOR THE DRIVER AND FRONT SEAT PASSENGER TO EMERGE FROM THE BANK. AS THE DRIVER EMERGED, MS. KELLIE GRINZO, AND PASSENGER, MR. NAJI YEARWOOD THEY APPEARED SURPRISED, AND MS. GRINZO IMMEDIATELY ASKED WHAT WAS WRONG, AND THEN APOLOGIZED FOR PARKING IN THE HANDICAPPED SPACE. MR. YEARWOOD DID NOT SAY ANYTHING, AND HE WAS TALKING ON HIS CELL PHONE THIS OFFICER TOLD HIM TO STAND BY THE VEHICLE, AND PUT HIS HANDS ON THE CAR, AS WELL MS. GRINZO. MR. YEARWOOD DID NOT COMPLY, AND HE PLACED HIS LEFT HAND IN HIS SHORTS POCKET. HE WAS THEN ORDERED TO REMOVE HIS HAND AND PLACE IT ON THE VEHICLE. HE IMMEDIATELY TURNED AND RAN WEST UP THE ALLEYWAY TO THE REAR ALLEY BETWEEN CHURCH ST., AND WILLOW ST.

THIS OFFICER CALLED OUT TO HIM TO STOP, AND HE CONTINUED TO FLEE.

THIS OFFICER THEN ADVISED DISPATCH TO SEND ASSISTANCE TO FIND MR. YEARWOOD. AND A DESCRIPTION AS WELL AS HIS NAME WERE GIVEN OUT OVER THE AIR.

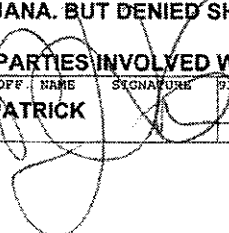
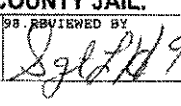
MS. GRINZO, AND MR. PIPELINE WERE PLACED UNDER ARREST. AND THE HEROIN WAS SEIZED FROM THE CENTER CONSOLE OF THE VEHICLE. IN THE SAME CONSOLE WAS LOCATED A SMALL BAG OF MARIJUANA.

THIS OFFICER WAS ALERTED BY A CONCERNED CITIZEN THAT MR. YEARWOOD HAD FLED INTO #16 WEST RAILROAD AVE. AND RAN UP THE REAR STAIRS. THIS OFFICER RESPONDED TO THAT BUILDING, AND SPOKE WITH MS. ELIZABETH DANSER SHE WAS ASKED IF ANYONE HAD COME THROUGH THE YARD OR RUN UPSTAIRS. SHE SAID "NO".

THIS OFFICER THEN ASKED IF IT WOULD BE ALL RIGHT IF WE LOOKED IN HER APARTMENT. SHE SAID "I DON'T GIVE A SHIT" "GO AHEAD". SHE FURTHER INDICATED THAT IT WAS HER DAUGHTER UPSTAIRS WITH HER GIRLFRIEND. THIS OFFICER ALONG WITH SGT. J. MENNUTI KNOCKED AT THE DOOR, AND WAS GREETED BY MS. DANSER'S DAUGHTER. WE ASKED WHO WAS IN THE HOUSE, AND SHE INDICATED HERSELF AND HER FRIENDS. MR. YEARWOOD WAS THEN LOCATED IN A BACK LIVING ROOM. HE WAS PLACED UNDER ARREST BY SGT. MENNUTI.

ALL THE PARTIES WERE BROUGHT BACK TO HEADQUARTERS WHERE THEY WERE PROCESSED, AND QUESTIONED ON VIDEO. NO ONE CLAIMED OWNERSHIP OF THE HEROIN. MR. YEARWOOD INDICATED THAT HE HAD SOME MARIJUANA IN HIS POCKET AND THAT IS WHY HE RAN. MS. GRINZO CLAIMED OWNERSHIP OF THE SMALL BAGGIE OF MARIJUANA. BUT DENIED SHE OWNED THE HEROIN. MR. PIPELING CLAIMED HE KNEW NOTHING. (VIDEO).

ALL THE PARTIES INVOLVED WERE CHARGED ACCORDINGLY, PROCESSED AND LODGED IN THE COUNTY JAIL.
