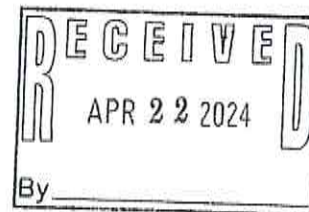

His body was cold to the touch, with the start of lividity, and Rigor mortis. Signs of life were checked with negative results of a pulse. ALS was requested and Saint Clare's Paramedics Andrew Bottoni and Joseph Subrizi responded to the scene. Bottoni contacted Saint Clare's Denville MD Mariya Cherneykina for a pronouncement at 1123 hours.

Morris County ME Investigator Brittany Floyd was notified of the circumstance around the unattended death and released the body at 1210 hours. On-Call Det. Torres was notified of the unattended death as well. Iliff & Ruggerio was contacted and provided transport of the body to their funeral home at 1458 hours.

The continued list of all prescribed medications to ~~XXXXXX~~ was taken by my BWC and photos attached to this CAD. Nothing was observed to be suspicious or foul play in correlation to the unattended death and I cleared thereafter without issue.
