Concluding from the scene, all evidence was transported to Police Headquarters and turned directly over to Det. Lt. Picca.

It should be noted while on scene with Robert [REDACTED], they explained to me about previous, undocumented incidents which occurred at there home. Approximately one month prior to the above detailed incident, the residence of 1317 Charles St was "egged" by an unknown individual and along the same timeline, an unknown individual knocked on [REDACTED] bedroom window located near the northwest corner of the home, on the west side. When she alerted [REDACTED], no one was seen on or near the property.

When asked if either Robert or [REDACTED] had any enemies or previous harassment issues with anyone in the past, Robert stated a male known as [REDACTED] used to bully [REDACTED] however, that was over one year prior and has since never had any further problems.

On 10/24/16 at approximately 1526 hours I, P.O. Barker responded to 1317 Charles St for a report of a possible burglary at the residence. Once on scene, I activated my marked patrol vehicle's Mobile Video Recording equipment and approached the single story residential dwelling from the east. As I approached the home, I observed an enclosed porch with a storm door which granted access to the interior of said porch. Once I arrived at the storm door, the caller, Robert Fitzpatrick greeted me and granted me entrance to the porch.

As I spoke to Mr. Fitzpatrick he introduced me [REDACTED]. The two individuals directed me to the northeast corner of the porch where I witnessed an orange pumpkin approximately the size of an ordinary basketball located on top of a vintage milk can. Carved into the pumpkin were the words "Fuck Ass Hole". On the top portion of the pumpkin I observed a metal object which was pierced into the rind (Skin). The metal object appeared to be similar in appearance to a metal pen clip.

[REDACTED] explained to me [REDACTED], [REDACTED] left the home through the front door at approximately 0750 hours and did not observe the pumpkin inside the porch. From 0750 to approximately 1445 hours, none of the residents were at the home. It was at 1445 hours, [REDACTED] enter the porch and observed the above described pumpkin. It was at this time she advised [REDACTED] via telephone. Robert then responded to the residence, observed the pumpkin himself and contacted Police Headquarters.

Robert advised me that the front door to the residence was locked however, the storm door granting access to the enclosed porch was not.

After speaking with Robert and [REDACTED] about the pumpkin, Robert directed me to the rear door of the home which was located on the west side of the property. Once there, he directed my attention to the concrete step leading to the rear door. There, I witnessed a blue and black plastic handled phillips head screwdriver which had small amounts of rust on it. Robert advised me the screwdriver belonged to him however, he and his family members did not place it on the concrete step. He found the screwdriver at approximately 0730 hours and thought it's location was suspicious.

Sgt. Woit arrived on scene.

After observing the physical evidence on scene, I began to inspect the exterior of the home for any signs of forced entry. The property's rear yard was open on the south side (No fence) allowing access to the rear yard from the street. I concluded my search with negative results at which point I obtained the Patrol Bureau's Digital Camera from my patrol vehicle and documented the scene including the physical evidence (Pumpkin and Screwdriver). Once the items were photographed, I recovered the physical evidence and placed them in my locked patrol vehicle.

At this time I began to canvass the immediate neighborhood on foot. I ultimately made contact with Kevin Henry of 1312 Charles St. Kevin advised me he was not home during the time frame indicated above however, he stated his home had a surveillance system which included an exterior video camera positioned on the southwest corner of his single story dwelling above his garage. The camera was directed in a northwest direction, capturing motion detected in front of the home.

Kevin supplied me with a copy of the surveillance footage the system captured between the hours of 0730
