Dear Resident,

The Galloway Township Police Department received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on 11/24/2020. The official Records Custodian, Captain Rich Barber, received your OPRA request on 11/24/2020. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is 12/7/2020. Your response was completed on the 4th business day.

For informational purposes, which may or may not apply to this request: investigatory records including investigation reports, incident reports, and supplemental reports are protected documents and exempt from disclosure pursuant to NJSA 47:1A-1 et seq., even after the investigation is complete. **Domestic violence reports are confidential and exempt from disclosure pursuant to NJSA 2C:25-33.** You are entitled to copies of your own complaints; however some information may have to be redacted pursuant to prevailing law.

Reports are enclosed as follows with a description of the legal basis for any denials or redactions as required by NJSA 47:1A-6:

Records requested:

1. Police dispatch logs of all incidents of police dispatched to the following locations from 1/1/2010-present: 301 Waveland Avenue and 219 E. White Horse Pike: **Filled** (redactions for privacy interest)
2. Incident reports, with narratives, for the following incident #s: 2011-00008456, 2011-00009681, 2011-00015436, 2011-00021970, 2011-00023332, 2011-00032737, 2012-00001289: **Filled** (redactions for privacy interest)

These records are being transmitted to you via: opra+request-18693-b4df3ea5@requests.opramachine.com, as per your request. Pursuant to NJSA 47:1A-5.b., the cost associated with this request is \$0.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Galloway Township Police Department to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council ("GRC") by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The Council can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.

Some documents not available through the Open Public Records Act may still be available through discovery or other legal processes. An attorney can advise you in this regard.
