Purpose: This Affidavit/Certification is to more fully describe the facts of the alleged offense so that a judge or authorized judicial officer may determine probable cause.

1. Description of relevant facts and circumstances which support probable cause that (1) the offense(s) was committed and (2) the defendant is the one who committed it:

On the above date and time, I, Ptl. Breslin #348, was dispatched to CVS, located at 2545 Hooper Avenue, to take a report of a shoplifting. Upon arrival, I spoke with the complainant, an employee of CVS, who stated that a male subject entered the store and picked up a prescription medication from the pharmacy. The male then proceeded to walk through the store, taking possession of various consumable goods before exiting past all points of sale without rendering payment.

The total value of the (7) seven items taken was \$129.73. CVS staff reviewed the pharmacy transaction records and were able to obtain the suspect's pedigree information, including name, address, and phone number. Utilizing my Mobile Data Terminal (MDT), I was able to positively identify the defendant as the suspect involved in the shoplifting incident.
