Narrative

On the above date and time I, Ptl. Manzo #46, was made aware of damage observed in the Maple Place School Gymnasium.

Upon arrival, I was greeted by Oceanport Basketball Association President, Jay Coffey. He showed me to the basketball gym, where he showed me what appeared to be pieces of shattered glass on the floor. Coffey advised that the gym floor was recently resealed on 12/23/15 during the afternoon.

Nobody had access to the gym since that date. Further observance of the gymnasium revealed a double pane glass window was broken approximately 20 feet off of the ground on the south side of the building.

Coffey did not believe that there was any foul play that caused the damage, and believes that the window broke do to its poor condition. Coffey had already notified the maintenance supervisor of Oceanport School District.

Prior to departing, I captured photographs of the damaged window, and the debris on the floor. I then left the school without further information. See attached photographs.

Narrative

Patrol responded to the Black Berry Bay Park for a an open gate to the public pool. Upon arrival, I was met by the complainant identified as Mayor Coffey of Oceanport. Later, Patrol was able to make contact with one of the Pool managers identified as Megan Mansfield who advised that she would respond out to secure the gate. Mayor Coffey and I remained on scene until Megan arrived.

Upon Megan's arrival, she was able to secure the gate with no issue. Additionally, Megan took photographs of the locked gate and advised that she would take care of this issue. Patrol cleared, NFI.

Please Note: Megan advised that the pool was closed on this date but 2(Two) employees were in the pool area and should have locked up after they left.
