We have been working very closely with our e-citation vendor, Brazos, the NJ Office of IT, and the AOC to restore connectivity. As of approximately 1200 hours on Tuesday, November 20th, the connection had been restored and our officers were once again able to issue e-citations.

Additionally, Sgt. Oliveri is currently testing a new build of the Brazos software that will allow officers to verify connection to the state *prior* to attempting to issue a summons. Hopefully this build will be ready in the coming weeks.

Officers should now be using Brazos when issuing warnings and summonses.
