If the officer does not investigate an alleged crash, the individual reporting the alleged crash should be directed to complete a Self-Reporting Motor Vehicle Crash report (SR-1) and submit it to the agency indicated on the form. The state no longer prints the Self Reporting Motor Vehicle Crash report (SR-1) (Self/walk in reports). Citizens requesting self-reports can go to the state police website <http://www.state.nj.us/mvc/pdf/about/SR-1.pdf> or our website www.brickpd.com - under the Forms Tab.

If a citizen is at headquarters and wishes to complete the form one will be provided to them. The desk officer will provide them a copy of the form if one is available or he/she will print the form from the above mentioned websites. Nothing is changing with the way we are currently handling "walk-ins".

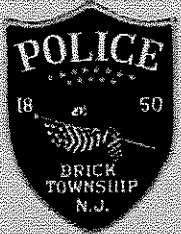

The vendor we use for e-ticketing, APS, is still experiencing sporadic outages. This issue is caused by the way their software interfaces with the NJ Court's servers and affects every APS customer in NJ. At this time officers can write summonses using e-ticket, however due to the sporadic outages the summons may fail. Unfortunately, officers will not know if there is an outage until he or she attempts to issue the summons. It is unknown when this issue will be completely resolved and based on the response from APS it may be several months.

We recommend that you use paper tickets at this point until the issue is corrected. If you still want to use e-ticketing you can.

We are also in the process of switching vendors for e-ticketing, which should take affect mid-April.

Just a reminder that back in 2016 during a personnel meeting, I encouraged you to take part in the Captain Buscio health screening program which is offered to active and retired police officers, firefighters and EMS personnel. The screening is offered at the Deborah Hospital facility in Browns Mills or at the Cardio Pulmonary Diagnostic Center in Newark. Any officer wishing to attend the screening may do so in lieu of their work day by working it out with your supervisors and the Operations Division secretary. The following is information provided by the program administrators.

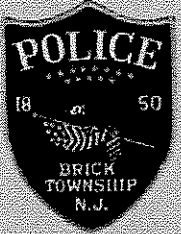
All current and retired firefighters, police, and emergency responders, and their officers are invited to participate in the program throughout the State of New Jersey. They will then have an opportunity to receive confidential comprehensive cardiovascular and pulmonary medical evaluations.

The medical facility will take the responsibility of billing the participant's insurance provider. These annual examinations are provided by Deborah Heart and Lung Center, and also Cardio Pulmonary Diagnostic, whose providers are board-certified cardiologists and pulmonologists who have generously offered firefighters, police, and emergency responders medical care that is specific to their profession.

All providers are board certified in the various specialties they provide. Testing will be provided based upon each participant's medical history. Testing may include laboratory, x-ray, pulmonary functions testing, and cardiovascular screening. Upon completion the participant will be provided with a medical report which they can use at their discretion.

All visits will be scheduled by appointment; the medical staff will direct you to what will be needed for the initial visit, such as bringing a list of all medications that you currently may be taking. In addition, fasting the previous night is required for blood work, which is part of the evaluation.

The county and Earle asphalt will be resurfacing multiple roads throughout the town. The three roadways that will be affected are Beaverson Boulevard, Cedar Bridge Avenue and Burnt Tavern Road Extension. The work will begin with concrete work starting the week of March 5th. Beaverson Boulevard is scheduled first, Cedar Bridge second and finally the Extension. After the concrete work is complete the milling and paving work will begin. Beaverson Boulevard is tentatively scheduled to start the week of April 9th. The schedule is subject to weather delays and may change. Currently there is no work planned for the overnight hours. The work hours are between 0900 hours to 1600 hours for work on the roadway. Work off of the road may continue until 1800 hours. It should be noted that the resurfacing of Cedar Bridge Avenue is from New Hampshire Avenue (Lakewood) to the Brick Township line. 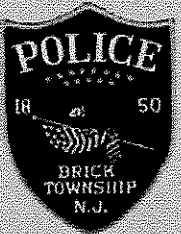

Recently, the Traffic Safety Unit received a query from patrol about vehicle insurance. The questions began when a driver, claiming to be driving for Uber, stated that he was covered by Uber's car insurance because he was on his way to pick someone up after being involved in a minor crash. The driver provided a copy of the policy to the officers on scene. Traffic Safety contacted Uber to verify the driver's claim. It was found that Uber does in fact cover drivers who are driving for them with a policy from Allstate. To be covered by the policy the driver must be "available" on the Uber app. While available, the driver is covered for \$100,000 in bodily injury coverage and \$25,000 in property damage. Once they are in route to pick up someone or have someone in their vehicle they are covered up to \$1,500,000 in coverage.

This insurance coverage does not allow drivers to operate their vehicle without their own vehicle insurance, the Uber policy is a supplement to someone's own insurance. When completing a NJTR-1 report list the driver's personal insurance information in boxes 24/54 and 25/55 and write in the narrative that the driver was driving for Uber, and list the insurance information in the narrative. Completing the report in this fashion will negate any fraud on part of the claimed Uber driver. For example the driver can start the app after the crash occurred and the officer would have no way to verify if he/she was driving for Uber at the time of a crash.
