Dear Mr. Kratovil:

My office is in receipt of your OPRA request dated January 6, 2019 and received the same. Below is an enumerated response to your requests:

1. The log of all incidents in the NBPB's CAD system from January 1, 2018 through December 10, 2018 exceeds 2500 pages. Pursuant to OPRA guidelines, certain personal identifying information as it pertains, but not limited to juveniles, domestic violence and sexual assault may be redacted. Due to the voluminous nature of this request, a special service fee will be assessed. My office estimates that the review and redaction process for the record(s) you seek will take approximately six-and-one-half (6 ½) hours, at an hourly rate of \$61.71 per hour, or an estimated total of \$401.12. The City Clerk's Office will accept a \$200.00 deposit if you wish to continue with this portion of the request. Upon receipt of the deposit, the record(s) will be reviewed and redacted accordingly. Upon completion, you be notified of the balance due and if the total of the service fee exceeds \$401.12, you will be notified in advance and provided the opportunity to withdraw or amend your request.

Additionally, in July of 2018 the New Brunswick Police Department (NBPB) entered a shared services agreement with the Rutgers University Police Department (RUPD) as it pertains to dispatch services. On December 10, 2018 the NBPB ceased operation of its own Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) system and went under the purview the RUPD CAD system. CAD records relevant to the NBPB after December 10, 2018 are no longer maintained by the NBPB, and are under the sole ownership and maintenance of the RUPD. I would recommend making a request to the RUPD for CAD records after December 10, 2018.

2. Attached are the record(s) responsive to your request, Be advised, that pursuant to OPRA guidelines, certain personal identifying information may be redacted; specifically but not limited to juvenile information. Additionally, arrests logged after December 9, 2018 are recorded in a different format due to the shared

services agreement with RUPD and the shift in software utilized by the departments.

3. Attached are the record(s) responsive to your request.
4. The New Brunswick Police Department cannot specifically search for “calls for service”, however the CAD report will show all calls handled by the NBPD. Any record(s) responsive to your request in Item #1 would apply.
5. Attached are the record(s) responsive to your request. Be advised, that pursuant to OPRA guidelines, certain personal identifying information may be redacted; specifically but not limited to juvenile information.
6. See response from the New Brunswick City Clerk’s Office.
