Dear Ms. Riccardi:

The Morris County Prosecutor's Office received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) and common law right of access request dated February 6, 2020, on February 7, 2020, and it was received by the records custodian on the same date. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is February 20, 2020. You requested the following:

Entire files, including but not limited to, copies of any and all reports, photos, and videos prepared and/or generated from a motor-vehicular accident on May 17, 2018 at approximately 10:20am located near mile marker 25.10 on Route 80 West.

Pursuant to OPRA, the following records are being provided and are responsive to your request:

1. Complaint—Warrant and Affidavit of Probable Cause No. 1427-W-2018-000161 (6 pages).
2. Complaint—Warrant and Affidavit of Probable Cause No. 1427-S-2019-000052 (14 pages).
3. Indictment No. 19-03-00253-I (8 pages).
4. NJTR-1 (5 pages).
5. Motor Vehicles Summonses (3 pages).
6. Mount Olive PD CAD Reports (11 pages).

Note: *Personal identifying information redacted pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1 and N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5(a). Information related to individuals' reasonable expectation of privacy redacted pursuant to Burnett v. Cty. of Bergen, 198 N.J. 408, 423 (2009); see N.J.S.A 47:1A-1. Information relating to "medical ... diagnosis, treatment or evaluation" has been redacted as it is not "considered government records subject to public access pursuant to*

N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1 et seq.” N.J.A.C. 10A:22-2.3(a); see also Executive Order No. 26 (Gov. McGreevey 2002).

Other than the above supplied records, access to the remainder of the contents of the investigation file related to this matter is denied, as they are considered criminal investigatory records. Such records are exempt from disclosure under OPRA pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1 to -13, and Janeczko v. Department of Law and Public Safety, Division of Criminal Justice, GRC Complaint Numbers 2002-79 and 2002-80 (affirmed on appeal May 2004). Criminal investigatory records are defined as records that are held by a law enforcement agency, which pertain to any criminal investigation and of which are not required by law to be made, maintained or kept on file. Ibid. A criminal investigatory record remains exempt from disclosure even after the criminal investigation has been closed. West Solloway v. Bergen County Prosecutor’s Office Custodian of Records, GRC Complaint No. 2011-39; Woojin Hwang v. Bergen County Prosecutor’s Office Custodian of Records, GRC Complaint No. 2011-348; Donna Janeczko v. New Jersey Department of Law and Public Safety, Division of Criminal Justice, Custodian of Record, GRC Complaint Nos. 2002-79 and 2002-80; Andrew Johnson/Press of Atlantic City v. New Jersey Division of State Police, Custodian of Record, GRC Complaint No. 2004-46. Cf. R. 1:38-3(f)(3) as to investigative police reports under the control of a court, unless they have been admitted into evidence.

Moreover, the New Jersey Supreme Court and the New Jersey Government Records Council have both held that records which are not “required by law to be made, maintained or kept on file,” are exempt from disclosure under OPRA when they pertain to any criminal investigation or related civil enforcement proceeding. See N. Jersey Media Grp., Inc. v. Twp. of Lyndhurst, 229 N.J. 541, 556 (2017) (citing N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1); see also, Kovacs v. Irvington Police Department, GRC Complaint No. 2014-196 (January 2015) (holding and observing that the Government Records Council “has long held that police incident reports” are exempt from disclosure under OPRA as “criminal investigatory records” when they pertain to any criminal investigation or related civil enforcement proceeding, citing Nance v. Scotch Plains Police Dep’t, GRC Complaint No. 2003-125 (January 2005); Rivera v. Passaic Cnty. Sheriff’s Office, GRC Complaint No. 2010-152 (May 2011); and Connelly v. Twp. of Montville, GRC Complaint No. 2013-59 (September 2013)); Rivera v. Town of West New York, GRC Complaint No. 2010-208 (February 2013), citing Bart v. City of Passaic, GRC Complaint No. 2007-162 (April 2008); and Executive Order No. 26 (Gov. McGreevey 2002); Hockensmith v. Atlantic Cnty. Prosecutor’s Office, GRC Complaint No. 2014-288 (Mar. 2015) (observing that under OPRA “criminal investigatory records include records involving all manner of crimes, resolved or unresolved, and includes *information that is part and parcel of an investigation, confirmed and unconfirmed.*”) (emphasis added and internal citations omitted).

You have also requested the records under the common law. Access under the common law requires that “the person seeking access must ‘establish an interest in the subject matter of the material’.” Mason v. City of Hoboken, 196 N.J. 51, 67 (2008) (quoting Keddie v. Rutgers, 148 N.J. 36, 50 (1997)). As your request fails to declare a particularized interest in the non-supplied

requested records, upon which a balancing of interests may be assessed, access to these records is also denied under common law. See O'Boyle v. Borough of Longport, 218 N.J. 168, 200 (2014).

The Office of the Morris County Prosecutor reserves the right to raise any other grounds for denial not raised in this response. Failure of the Office of the Morris County Prosecutor to assert an exception or privilege does not act as a waiver of any grounds for denial. Furthermore, a reviewing Court or the Government Record's Council ("GRC") may deem a denial of access to be authorized on grounds other than those advanced by a custodian. Paff v. Twp. of Plainsboro, A-2122-05T2, 2007 WL 957289, at *2 (N.J. Super. Ct. App. Div. Apr. 2, 2007) affirming, Paff v. Township of Plainsboro, GRC Complaint No. 2005-29 (March 2006).

You have a right to challenge the decision by the Office of the Morris County Prosecutor to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the GRC by completing Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free by telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at PO Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or on the GRC's website at www.state.nj.us/grc. The Council can also answer other questions about the law.

Note that any challenge to a denial of a request for records under the common law cannot be made to the GRC, as the GRC only has jurisdiction to adjudicate challenges to denials of OPRA requests. A challenge to the denial of access under the common law can be made by filing an action in Superior Court. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the New Jersey Superior Court Clerk.

This OPRA request is now deemed answered and closed.

Purpose: This Affidavit/Certification is to more fully describe the facts of the alleged offense so that a judge or authorized judicial officer may determine probable cause.

1. Description of relevant facts and circumstances which support probable cause that (1) the offense(s) was committed and (2) the defendant is the one who committed it:

This Affiant has probable cause to believe that on May 17, 2018, Hudy Muldrow, committed acts constituting the crimes of Reckless Vehicular Homicide/Death by Auto. Specifically, Hudy Muldrow's conduct on said date resulted in the deaths of M.V., date of birth [REDACTED] 2007, and J.W., date of birth [REDACTED] 1966.

On the morning of May 17, 2018, Hudy Muldrow, while acting as a school bus driver for the Paramus School District, operated a school bus (hereinafter "Hudy Muldrow's bus" or "Bus #2") scheduled for a student-teacher trip to Waterloo Village in Byram Township. Hudy Muldrow's bus, or Bus #2, is more particularly described as a 2012 International school bus. Hudy Muldrow was operating one of three (3) buses (hereinafter Bus #1, "Hudy Muldrow's bus" or "Bus #2", and Bus #3) that was occupied with students and teachers from East Brook Middle School. Hudy Muldrow's bus was occupied by approximately thirty-eight (38) students, and six (6) teachers and/or aides. Among the passengers were M.V., a 5th grade student at East Brook Middle School, and J.W., a teacher at East Brook Middle School. The investigation has revealed that Bus #2, as well as the two (2) other buses, left the school at approximately 9:20 a.m. en route to Waterloo Village. The buses travelled on New Jersey roads. Shortly after 10:00 a.m., the three (3) buses exited Interstate 80 West at exit 25 onto Route 206 North. It is believed that shortly thereafter, the three (3) buses missed a turn that would have taken them to Waterloo Village. It is further believed that the three (3) buses drove in an effort to correct their route. Bus #3 detached from the other two buses and arrived at Waterloo Village without incident. Thereafter, it is believed that Bus #2 separated from Bus #1. Bus #1 eventually arrived at Waterloo Village. It is believed that after Bus #1 and Bus #2 separated, Bus #2 travelled on Route 206 South towards the on ramp leading to Route 80 Westbound. It is further believed that at or near the point of entry onto Route 80 Westbound from the on ramp, Hudy Muldrow turned Bus #2 to the left in an apparent attempt to gain access to the official-use only access point located between the East and Westbound lanes of Route 80.

2. I am aware of the facts above because: (Included, but not limited to: your observations, statements of eyewitnesses, defendant's admission, etc.)

As part of this maneuver, Hudy Muldrow turned Bus #2 so that it was positioned in an almost-perpendicular direction in relation to the lanes of travel on Route 80 Westbound. Route 80 Westbound in this area is a three (3) lane highway. At this time, Bus #2 was impacted by a dump truck that was travelling in the center lane of Route 80 Westbound. The dump truck can more particularly be described as one (1) red 2013 Kenworth dump truck. The impact occurred on the left side of Bus #2, near the rear of the vehicle. As a result of the impact, Bus #2 was redirected and came to rest in the center median. Hudy Muldrow failed to maintain Bus #2 in its designated lane of travel when executing this maneuver. Hudy Muldrow disregarded the marked No Turn sign and turned Bus #2 to the left in an apparent attempt to gain access to an official-use only access point located between the East and Westbound lanes of Route 80.

3. If victim was injured, provide the extent of the injury:

Hudy Muldrow did not have lawful access to the official-use only access point located between the East and Westbound lanes of Route 80.

At approximately 10:20 a.m., law enforcement was notified of this incident. Upon arrival, the body of Bus #2 was discovered laying on its left side in the median of the roadway. The body of Bus #2 had detached from the chassis of the vehicle due to the force of the impact with the dump truck.

Further investigation revealed that the crash resulted in two (2) fatalities, specifically the deaths of M.V. and J.W. In addition, the crash resulted in numerous injuries to other occupants of Bus #2. The driver of the dump truck also sustained various injuries. Purpose: This Affidavit/Certification is to more fully describe the facts of the alleged offense so that a judge or authorized judicial officer may determine probable cause.

1. Description of relevant facts and circumstances which support probable cause that (1) the offense(s) was committed and (2) the defendant is the one who committed it:

On the morning of May 17, 2018, Hudy Muldrow, while acting as a school bus driver for the Paramus School District, operated a school bus (hereinafter "Muldrow's bus" or "Bus #2") scheduled for a student-teacher trip to Waterloo Village in Byram Township. Muldrow's bus, or Bus #2, is more particularly described as a 2012 International school bus. Muldrow's bus was occupied by approximately thirty-eight (38) students, and six (6) teachers and/or aides from East Brook Middle School.

During the trip, Bus #2 entered onto Route 80 Westbound and Muldrow turned Bus #2 to the left in an apparent attempt to gain access to the official-use only access point located between the East and Westbound lanes of Route 80. As part of this maneuver, Muldrow turned Bus #2 so that it was positioned in an almost-perpendicular direction in relation to the lanes of travel on Route 80 Westbound. Muldrow failed to maintain Bus #2 in its designated lane of travel when executing this maneuver. Muldrow disregarded the marked No Turn sign and turned Bus #2 to the left in an apparent attempt to gain access to an official-use only access point located between the East and Westbound lanes of Route 80. Muldrow did not have lawful access to the official-use only access point located between the East and Westbound lanes of Route 80. At this time, Bus #2 was impacted by a red 2013 Kenworth dump truck that was travelling in the center lane of Route 80 Westbound. Reference is made to W-2018-000161-1427 and S-2019-000051-1427 for further details related to this crash.

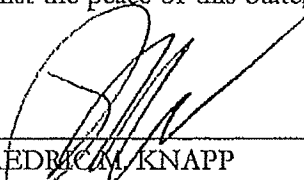

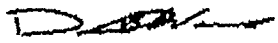

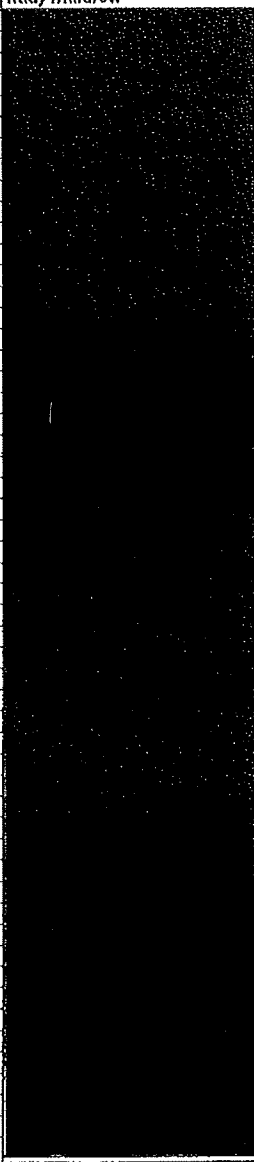
