FOLLOW-UP REPORT ON FATAL MOTORCYCLE ACCIDENT CASE #112635

DATE OF ACCIDENT: JUNE 14, 1986

TIME OF ACCIDENT: 12:53 A.M.

LOCATION OF " : EAST COUNTY LINE AND BROOK ROADS, LAKEWOOD TWP.

The undersigned was informed of a serious motor vehicle accident at East County Line Road and Brook Road by the desk officer, William Brower.

Proceeded to the scene by way of West County Line Road, across Route 9 and then to Brook Road. Upon arriving at the area of the accident it was observed that traffic was being detoured. There was a motorcycle in the center of County Line Road. A car was off the road facing east on the southside of the road. There was damage to the front and right side and windshield. The gas tank of the motorcycle was quite a distance east of the scene.

The First Aid and the Para-Medics were working on the cycle driver. He was next to the right side of the car. The driver was in the vehicle, driver's seat. She stated at the scene that that she was travelling east, the cycle came out of Brook Road travelling south. Both drivers were taken to the Kimball Medical Center by the First Aid.

Was informed by the Kimball Medical Center that the man passed away at 2:35 a.m. He was pronounced by Dr. William Schulman.

A next of kin was located and he made identification. He is a Mr. Asti, the stepfather of Mr. Matheson.

It was found that the motorcycle driver was a Mr. John D. Matheson. The driver of the car was a Miss Diana Hurley. Miss Hurley was treated and released from the hospital. Miss Hurley came in on June 16, 1986 and gave a statement in relation to the accident (please see her statement).

Measurements were taken of the accident scene for a scale diagram.

Sgt. Richard Smith took photos of the scene.

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MOTORCYCLE ACCIDENT CASE #112635
JUNE 25, 1986
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In the statement given by Miss Hurley, mention was made that she did not see see a headlight on at the time of the accident. The tail-light was on after the accident. This officer observed that.

On June 17, 1986, this officer along with Sgt. Richard Smith made observations of the motorcycle. The headlight was not broken. The headlight was removed and taken apart. There were loose wires inside. Said lamp will be sent to the Ocean County Lab.

At approximately 10:00 a.m. on June 17, 1986, a Mr. Avidikian called stating that one of the helmets was his. He let Matheson use it to go pick someone up. They met at Woodie's Bar on Route 9 in Howell Township. Matheson left the bar before midnight. He did not look like he was drunk when he left. He was going to give someone a ride home. He never came back.

June 17, 1986, Sgt. Richard Smith and this Officer went to Woodie's Bar and talked to the owner. He said he was not working at night but his son, Dave Scholl and Jim Ryan was (Phone: Dave - [REDACTED] and Jim - [REDACTED]).

Called Dave Scholl on June 17th. Dave said he talked to Matheson about 11:00 p.m., he looked o.k. at that time. Matheson had two beers. There was a girl at the bar that Matheson was talking to. Will try and find her name and number.

A Mr. Asti, Matheson's step-father, came to the Traffic and Safety Division office and picked up his personal belongings. He made mention to Sgt. Richard Smith that the headlight was not working a couple of days ago. He went on to say that Matheson got a few summonses. He will let us know what they are for. Mr. Asti signed for and received the personal belongings of Mr. Matheson.

June 18, 1986, received information that Mr. Matheson obtained a insurance policy and made his best friend the beneficiary. Contacted Roden Lightbody and was informed that he was told by Anita Zalon (Home Phone [REDACTED] Business Phone #681-9708) of the insurance situation. It was a [REDACTED] policy.

The undersigned contacted the Prosecutor's office on June 19, 1986 at approximately 9:00 A.M. and talked to Mr. Scott. Requested he have someone stop in and we will turn over all information.
