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145. Crash Description

Dispatch:

On Saturday, April 23, 2022, at approximately 1439 hours, I was dispatched to the Smithville CVS (1 S. New York Rd) for a possible hit and run motor vehicle crash. Dispatch provided a registration of the vehicle that left the scene of URU48X/NJ.

Arrival at scene:

Upon arriving at the scene, I met with the operator of the struck vehicle (V2). The female stated she parked her vehicle and entered the CVS. As she returned she observed a large scratch on the driver side of her vehicle which was not present prior to her going into the store.

I went into the CVS to review video surveillance. The video surveillance shows a silver/blue Chrysler Mini Van parking next to V2. You can see V1 enter the parking space and gets extremely close to V2. Due to the angle of the surveillance, it is unclear if V1 strikes V2.

Driver 1 (D1) of Vehicle 1 (V1):

I made contact with D1 of V1 at her residence. D1 of V1 advised she did not feel her self striking V2 at the CVS. D1 advised she believed she had at least one foot on each side of her vehicle when she parked. I observed what appeared to be fresh marks on the front of her vehicle which matched where V2 had its damage. I obtained D1's insurance information.
