The following is in response to your 5-part OPRA request. Regarding your requests:

1: Police Chief Bordi Emails to Berlin Twp Officers 8/1/22 -12/31/22 and 2: Police Chief Bordi Email received from Berlin Twp Officers from 8/1/22 -12/31/22: See attached emails in Response Docs.

3: Police Chief Bordi Time Sheets 8/1/22 - 12/31/22 is denied:

Personnel Records are exemption under N.J.S.A. 47:1A-10. 47:1A-10: Personnel, pension records not considered public information; exceptions. Notwithstanding the provisions of P.L. 1963, c. 73 (C. 47:1A-1 et seq.) or any other law to the contrary, the personnel or pension records of any individual in the possession of a public agency, including but not limited to records relating to any grievance filed by or against an individual, shall not be considered a government record and shall not be made available for public access. Therefore, this portion of your request is denied.

4: Police Chief Bordi Daily Logs 8/1/22 -12/31/22 is denied:

Personnel Records are exemption under N.J.S.A. 47:1A-10. 47:1A-10: Personnel, pension records not considered public information; exceptions. Notwithstanding the provisions of P.L. 1963, c. 73 (C. 47:1A-1 et seq.) or any other law to the contrary, the personnel or pension records of any individual in the possession of a public agency, including but not limited to records relating to any grievance filed by or against an individual, shall not be considered a government record and shall not be made available for public access.
