Re: Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request – record of all calls and police reports

Dear Mr. Dimiko:

This office is in receipt of your request made under the New Jersey Open Public Records Act (OPRA) wherein you are seeking “a record of all calls and police reports made to the Brick Township PD and the Ocean County Sheriffs office between 1/1/2006 and 12/31/2024 by Alexandra Logg DOB 10/24/1989.”

Please be advised that your request is impermissibly vague and overbroad, as it does not identify any specific records or documents in existence; instead, it asks for research to determine which records or documents pertain to the request.

While OPRA provides an alternative means of access to government documents not otherwise exempted from its reach, it is not intended as a research tool litigants may use to force government officials to identify and siphon useful information. Rather, OPRA simply operates to make identifiable government records “readily accessible for inspection, copying, or examination.”

See MAG Entm't, LLC v. Div. of Alcoholic Beverage Control, 375 N.J. Super. 534, 546 (App. Div. 2005).
