On the above date and time, I, Ptl. Morris, was on duty in marked patrol vehicle #24. While on patrol in the area of Hamilton Avenue and Central Avenue (the parallel road that runs adjacent to Central Avenue), I observed a blue Jeep wagon traveling north on Central Avenue. I saw the vehicle strike several curbs, and as it crossed the intersection of Hamilton Avenue and Central Avenue, the front driver's side tire appeared to pop.

The vehicle did not stop and continued traveling north on Central Avenue at a low rate of speed toward my patrol vehicle. As the vehicle approached, I placed my patrol vehicle in reverse and activated my emergency lights and siren in an attempt to conduct a motor vehicle stop.

The suspect vehicle came to a stop and parked in the area of Sumner Avenue and Central Avenue. At this time, I exited my patrol vehicle and approached the driver's side of the suspect vehicle, identified as a blue Jeep wagon bearing New Jersey registration CCNU73.

Upon approaching the driver's side, I observed that all the vehicle's windows were rolled up. I requested that the driver, later identified as Ashley Kirk, roll the window down. I identified myself and informed Ms. Kirk that I had observed her vehicle strike multiple curbs. Ms. Kirk replied, "No, I did not." I then asked Ms. Kirk if she had consumed any alcoholic beverages that evening, to which she stated, "No." I asked her where she was coming from, and she stated, "Beachcomber." I followed up by asking, "You didn't have anything to drink at Beachcomber?" Ms. Kirk then admitted, "I did have drinks." When asked how many drinks she had consumed, she replied, "Three." It should also be noted that while speaking with Ms. Kirk, I observed her swaying back and forth, and that I was able to detect a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from the interior of the vehicle. I then requested her driver's license, vehicle registration, and proof of insurance.

At this time, Ptl. DiFabio arrived on scene. I briefed Ptl. DiFabio on my observations and the circumstances leading up to the stop. Ptl. DiFabio then exited his patrol vehicle and began to conduct Standardized Field Sobriety Testing (SFST) on the female driver. (Refer to Ptl. DiFabio's report for further details regarding the testing.)

Once all the tests were complete, based on Ptl. DiFabio's observations, I then placed Ms. Kirk under arrest for driving under the influence of alcohol and was placed in the rear seat of my patrol vehicle to be transported to the Seaside Heights Booking Room.

Upon arrival at the Seaside Heights Police Headquarters, Ms. Kirk was read her Miranda Rights followed by the implied consent form in regards to providing sample of her breath. Ms. Kirk advised me that she understood her rights and stated "Yes" to providing samples of her breath for testing. Once the twenty (20) minute observation period was completed, Ptl. Leahy escorted Ms. Kirk into the Alcotest room to administer the Alcotest.

After receiving two valid breath samples, the reported breath test was 0.26% B.A.C.. The breath samples that were taken were within the acceptable tolerance which was checked utilizing the state of NJ Alcotest Calculator though NCIC.

At this time, I began to complete the booking and processing of the female. Ms. Kirk was later released to a friend, Ms. Cherego who came to Police Headquarters and completed the potential liability form and took custody of Ms. Kirk.

On the above date and time this officer PTL DiFabio responded to Central and Sumner Avenue as back up for patrolman Morris on a traffic stop. I exited out of my patrol car and spoke to Ptl. Morris briefly, before walking over to the occupant in the vehicle. As I approached, I could clearly see the woman inside hunched over in the drivers seat. I asked her some questions and her speech appeared slurred and her eyes droopy. It looks like she could possibly be intoxicated, i then asked her out of the vehicle and asked her if she would perform sobriety tests to which she agreed.

As she walked over with myself to the area that we're going perform the test, She was having trouble walking, stumbling at times and unable to keep her balance.

At this time I asked her if she had any physical impairments, she confirmed that she did not. Before beginning the test she was instructed to place her right foot front of her left foot. As she attempted to perform this action she lost her balance numerous times so much that I had to abort the instruction and advise her to stand with both her feet side-by-side as she normally would while standing. She became very emotional and started to cry.

After she gathered herself The first test that was described to her that she would be performing was the walk and turn test. We would be performing the test on the straight white line in a parking lot. I told her that I will perform the test first and she is to stand in place and watch until I'm finished. I told her what she will do is she will walk down nine steps heel to toe counting out loud looking down at her feet when she got to the end take a series of small steps and in the opposite direction and perform nine steps back. As she began the test, She failed to properly touch heel to toe, stumbled multiple times and at the beginning, failing to count the numbers out loud until I advised her again after the test was already started.

Upon completion of the first test, I began to advise her of the second test. This test was the one legged stand test. Before advising her of the test and performing it I asked her if she had any physical problems with her legs, which is she confirmed that she did not. Again I told her to stand in place as I described and performed the test. I told her to raise the leg of her choice 6 inches off the ground with her toes pointed and I wanted her to count one 1000, two 1000 , three 1000, four 1000 until I advised her to stop, i then asked her if she understood these instructions to which she agreed. Miss Gray attempted to raise her leg, but could not keep her balance stumbling over each time at which time she almost fell. This happened multiple times at which time I decided to abort the test at that time

After i took the woman through the field sobriety test i advised her that there would be one more test, the hgn test. I gave her instructions to watch the pen in my hand that was held out in front of her head approximately twelve inches, and she was advised to follow the tip of the pen with her eyes only, while not moving her head. I asked her if she had understood these instructions which she stated that she understood. During the hgn test lack of smooth pursuit was checked and it was present in both eyes. The second test i checked for nystagmus at maximum deviation and observed it to be distinct and sustained in both eyes. The third test i checked for nystagmus prior to forty-five (45) degrees and observed it to be present in both eyes. Lastly i checked for vertical gaze nystagmus and did not find it to be present. I then advised Ptl Morris of my observations at which time the female was placed under arrest for dwi. (See Ptl Morris report)

I, PATROL OFFICER ANDREW LEAHY AM A CERTIFIED ALCOTEST OPERATOR AND OPERATED THE ALCOTEST 9510 MACHINE FOR PATROL OFFICER RACHEL MORRIS WHO HAD PLACED MS. ASHLEY M. KIRK UNDER ARREST FOR DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE. ONCE THE TWENTY MINUTE OBSERVATION PERIOD OF MS. KIRK ENDED, SHE WAS ESCORTED INTO THE ALCOTEST ROOM WHERE I TOOK CUSTODY OF HER. I ALSO MAINTAINED CONSTANT EYE CONTACT OF MS. KIRK AND CHECKED HER MOUTH FOR ANY FOREIGN OBJECTS, WITH NEGATIVE FINDINGS. IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT PRIOR TO ENTERING THE ALCOTEST ROOM, I REMOVED MY DUTY FIREARM, MY PORTABLE RADIO AND ALL ELECTRONICS FROM MY PERSON AND ENTERED ALL NECESSARY INFORMATION INTO THE ALCOTEST MACHINE. MS. KIRK ALSO HAD NO PERSONAL PROPERTY OR ELECTRONICS IN HER POSSESSION AT THIS TIME.

PRIOR TO PERFORMING THIS TEST, A NEW MOUTH PIECE WAS UTILIZED FOR EACH TEST GIVEN AND I ALSO ADVISED MS. KIRK EACH TIME TO TAKE A DEEP BREATH AND BLOW INTO THE MOUTHPIECE WITH ONE LONG CONTINUOUS BREATH AND TO CONTINUE TO BLOW UNTIL SHE WAS ADVISED TO STOP, WHICH SHE STATED SHE UNDERSTOOD BEFORE EACH TEST WAS GIVEN. MS. KIRK PROVIDED TWO VALID BREATH SAMPLES. THE TEST RESULTS WERE 0.260% . THE BREATH SAMPLES TAKEN WERE WITHIN ACCEPTABLE TOLERANCE WHICH WAS CHECKED UTILIZING THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY ALCOTEST CALCULATOR THROUGH OUR COUNTY DISPATCH.

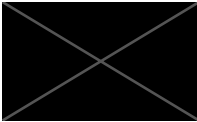
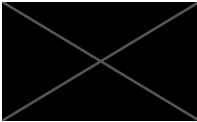

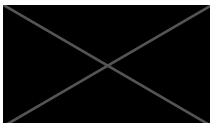
