Upon arrival, patrols spoke with the complainant, Megan Giordano, who stated that she got into a verbal argument with her boyfriend, Tyler Doyle, which ultimately got physical. Megan explained how Tyler left work early today and didn't arrive home until approximately 45 minutes after clocking out of work which started their first verbal argument. Megan added that Tyler made comments about not wanting to be home so he left the apartment around approximately 8:30PM before returning home at approximately 11:30PM and was intoxicated. Megan continued by saying that another verbal argument started over a phone charger. Megan stated that Tyler then pushed her into a corner of the living room before grabbing her throat with one hand and holding her left arm

with his other hand. Megan continued by saying that while he choked, she couldn't breathe for 30 seconds. Patrols observed red marks on Megan's throat and left arm area.

Tyler denied the allegations.

Megan was advised of her Domestic Violence Rights and a Victim Notification Form was completed and signed by her indicating that she did not wish to pursue a Temporary Restraining Order at this time. Megan also provided a written statement regarding the incident. Photographs of the red marks on Megan were taken on scene by Officer Vex.

Tyler was placed under arrest and transported to headquarters where he was photographed, finger printed, and an arrest report was started. Tyler was advised of his Miranda Rights by Officer Siek and waived his rights. While in the processing room, Tyler began to hit head on the table multiple times causing him to have a small laceration on his nose. Newton First Aid Squad was dispatched to headquarters to assess Tyler for his injury, where he ultimately signed an RMA.

Assistant Prosecutor Neidhardt was notified at 2:00AM on recorded line 1 and advised of the incident. AP Neidhardt recommended the charge to be 2C:12-1A(1) Simple Assault, a Disorderly Persons Offense, and was put on a complaint summons 1915-S-2022-000092. Tyler was served the Summons and advised of his court date of 8/9/22 at 9:00AM at Newton Municipal Court prior to his release.

Megan was advised of Tylers release at 3:19AM.

Sergeant Teets spoke with DCP&P and advised them of the incident. DCP&P advised that there would be a 24 hour response.

Photos of Megan's injury were burned to a CD, entered into the BEAST, and submitted into evidence locker #9.

All proper DV Notification emails were made. All proper checks were conducted.
