INCIDENT # : I-2019-021062

ON THURSDAY, AUGUST 1 AT 2038 HOURS PATROL UNITS WERE DISPATCHED TO 638 8TH STREET IN REFERENCE A NEIGHBOR DISPUTE. POLICE COMMUNICATION ADVISED RESPONDING UNIT THAT THE DISPUTE WAS NOW PHYSICAL.

UPON MY ARRIVAL, PARTIES WERE SEPARATED. FROM THE EARLIER CALL (CASE I-2019-21060) I NOTICED VINCENT BANCHERI'S VEHICLE WAS STILL PARKED IN FRONT OF HIS NEIGHBORS RESIDENCE HOWEVER IT WAS MOVED FORWARD SLIGHTLY. I FIRST MADE CONTACT WITH VINCENT BANCHERI WHO WAS VISIBLY UPSET. HIS SHIRT WAS TORN AND HE APPEARED TO BE IN PAIN. HE EXPLAINED THAT HE WAS INJURED AFTER BEING ATTACKED. I ASKED BANCHERI IF THE ALTERCATION WAS THE RESULT OF THE LOCATION WHERE HE PARKED HIS VEHICLE AND HE STATED IT WAS. BANCHERI STATED THAT HIS NEIGHBORS GANGED UP ON HIM, SCRATCHING HIS VEHICLE, AND SPIT ON HIM. HE DESCRIBED THE ACCUSED AS A MALE WEARING A RED HAT ALONG WITH A FEMALE. HE WENT ONTO EXPLAIN THAT HE WAS PLACED IN A HEAD LOCK AND KICKED SEVERAL TIMES WHILE SCREAMING FOR HELP. FROM THE ALTERCATION BANCHERI HAD COMPLAINTS OF NECK PAIN AND REQUESTED MEDICAL TREATMENT. WHILE SGT MARKMAN REMAINED WITH BANCHERI I MADE CONTACT WITH THE OTHER INVOLVED PARTY.

I MADE CONTACT WITH CAROL ANDERSON AND ASHLEY BROWN. BROWN IDENTIFIED HERSELF AS THE DAUGHTER OF ANDERSON. BROWN WAS AWARE OF THE ONGOING ISSUES WITH HER MOTHERS NEIGHBOR. PRIOR TO OUR ARRIVAL SHE OBSERVED BANCHERI RETURNING HOME AND WAS PARKING HIS VEHICLE IN FRONT OF THEIR PROPERTY ONTO THE GRASS. BROWN APPROACHED BANCHERI IN AN ATTEMPT TO RESOLVE THE PARKING ISSUE. ACCORDING TO BROWN HE BECAME UPSET AND TOLD HER TO MIND HER OWN BUSINESS. HE BEGAN TO CALL HER OBSCENITIES BEFORE SPITTING IN HER FACE. WITH ANDERSON STANDING ON HER PORCH SHE OBSERVED THE ARGUMENT ESCALATING. ANDERSON AND BROWN BOTH EXPLAINED THAT BANCHERI PULLED A SHARP OBJECT OUT AND BEGAN SWINGING IT TOWARDS BROWN TELLING HER, "IF YOU DON'T GET AWAY FROM ME IM GONNA CUT YOU ALL". IN SHOCK FROM HIS THREAT, SHE FROZE AND HE SAID, "LOOK AT YOU PUSSY, BITCH". ANDERSON DESCRIBED THE WEAPON SHOWN AS A POSSIBLE BOX CUTTER, WHILE BROWN DESCRIBED IT AS KNIFE. BANCHERI THEN PLACED THE KNIFE IN A SMALL BLACK BAG THAT SHE DESCRIBED AS A FANNYPACK.

I ASKED BOTH BROWN AND ANDERSON IF THERE WAS ANYONE ELSE PRESENT DURING THIS ALTERCATION, PARTICULARLY A MALE WEARING A RED HAT. BROWN IDENTIFIED HIM AS TONY CRUZ WHO IS A CONTRACTOR HIRED BY ANDERSON TO INSTALL HER FENCE. ANDERSON MENTIONED THAT CRUZ LEFT ONCE HE OBSERVED BANCHERI BRANDISH THE WEAPON.

I ASKED BROWN AND ANDERSON IF THEY KNEW WHERE THE BLACK FANNYPACK WAS LOCATED. BROWN STATED THAT HE PLACED IT IN HIS VEHICLE. BANCHERI'S VEHICLE WAS PARKED WITH BOTH FRONT WINDOWS IN THE DOWN POSITION. ON THE DRIVERS FLOORBOARD THE BLACK BACK PACK WAS LOCATED AS DESCRIBED BY BROWN. THE BAG CONSISTED OF BANCHERI'S WALLET, PAPERS, AND CUTICLE NIPPER SCISSORS (SEE ATTACHED PHOTOS). THE SCISSORS HAD A RUBBER COATED GRIP WITH A LONG POINTY SILVER TIP. THE BAG WAS SECURED IN MY PATROL VEHICLE AS EVIDENCE.

OFFICER O'HARA MADE CONTACT WITH MICHAEL AND TERESA COHEN OF 639 8TH STREET. AFTER SPEAKING WITH THEM THEY STATED THE FOLLOWING. BOTH WERE SITTING ON THEIR PORCH AND ABLE TO HEAR THE ALTERCATION BUT HAD DIFFICULTY SEEING IT DUE TO THE TIME OF DAY. THEY OBSERVED BANCHERI LEAVE IN HIS VEHICLE AND RETURN A SHORT TIME LATER PARKING IN THE SAME PLACE. AFTER HE RETURNED, HE WAS CONFRONTED ABOUT THE PARKING SPACE BY A MALE WEARING WEARING A RED HAT AND FEMALE. THEY HEARD THEM ARGUING AT WHICH TIME THE THREAT WAS MADE, "IM GONNA CUT YOU, IM GONNA KILL YOU" THEY ADDED THAT THEY WERE UNAWARE OF WHO MADE THE THREAT, NOR DID THEY OBSERVE A WEAPON.

DAVID AUSTIN OF 635 8TH STREET WAS RETURNING HOME AND APPROACHED OFFICERS ON SCENE. AUSTIN MENTIONED HE HAD SURVEILLANCE CAMERAS ON HIS HOME AND VOLUNTARILY ASKED IF HE COULD BE ANY ASSISTANCE TO THE INVESTIGATION. I PROVIDED HIM WITH THE TIME OF THE ALTERCATION AND HE COPIED THE INCIDENT ONTO A MICRO SD CARD. I TOOK OWNERSHIP OF THE MICRO SD CARD AND ADVISED AUSTIN THAT I WOULD TRANSFER THE VIDEO TO A CD THEN RETURN HIS CARD TO HIM.

AFTER SPEAKING WITH THE INVOLVED PARTIES BANCHERI WAS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY. AT THIS TIME BANCHERI WISHED TO BE EVALUATED AND WAS TRANSPORTED TO ATLANTICARE REGIONAL MEDICAL FACILITY MAINLAND CAMPUS. AT THE HOSPITAL BANCHERI REFUSED TO IDENTIFY HIMSELF OR GIVE ANY INFORMATION TO THE MEDICAL STAFF. HOSPITAL STAFF ATTEMPTED RENDER AID, HOWEVER HE STATED HE DID NOT WANT TO BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY HOSPITAL BILLS. DOCTORS INFORMED ME THAT THEY COULD NOT HELP BANCHERI IF HE WAS UNCOOPERATIVE TOWARDS THEM AND HE WAS TRANSPORTED TO THE ABSECON POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR PROCESSING.

AT POLICE HEADQUARTERS BANCHERI CONTINUED TO BE UNCOOPERATIVE. I ADVISED HIM THAT HE WAS BEING CHARGED WITH TERRORISTIC THREATS, POSSESSION OF WEAPON FOR UNLAWFUL PURPOSE, AND UNLAWFUL PURPOSE OF A WEAPON. FROM THE DEGREE OF THE CHARGES I ADVISED HIM THAT HE MUST BE FINGERPRINTED. AFTER SEVERAL ATTEMPTS TO CONVINCE BANCHERI TO COOPERATE HE STILL REFUSED TO BE FINGERPRINTED. HE WAS SUBSEQUENTLY CHARGED WITH OBSTRUCTION OF ADMINISTRATION OF LAW AND REFUSAL TO SUBMIT FINGERPRINTS.

POLICE COMMUNICATIONS ADVISED THAT THE WALK-IN WAS IN REFERENCE TO AN INCIDENT WHICH HAD OCCURRED ON THURSDAY AUGUST 1ST, 2019. I MET WITH THE COMPLAINANT, VINCENT J. BANCHERI JR. MR. BANCHERI STATED THAT HE WISHED TO SIGN COMPLAINTS FOR ASSAULT. MR. BANCHERI REITERATED WHAT HE HAD TOLD PTL. IMBERTI #848 AT THE SCENE OF THE INCIDENT. MR. BANCHERI STATED THAT DURING THE EARLIER INCIDENT HE WAS ASSAULTED BY A MALE AND A FEMALE. MR. BANCHERI STATED THAT HE WAS PUT IN A HEAD LOCK, PUNCHED AND KICKED APPROXIMATELY A DOZEN TIMES BY BOTH PARTIES. MR. BANCHERI ADVISED THAT HE WAS ALSO STRUCK IN THE FACE WITH A STICK BY THE MALE. MR. BANCHERI STATED THAT HE SUSTAINED INJURIES DURING THE ASSAULT. MR. BANCHERI SHOWED ME A SMALL CUT ON THE TIP OF HIS NOSE AND A SMALL CUT ON THE RIGHT SIDE OF HIS FACE ABOVE HIS LIP. MR. BANCHERI ALSO STATED THAT HE HAD AN ABRASION ON HIS LIP, WHICH WAS COVERED BY HIS MUSTACHE. MR. BANCHERI ALSO STATED THAT THE BACK OF HIS HEAD WAS SENSITIVE TO THE TOUCH. MR. BANCHERI STATED THAT HE ALSO HAS PAIN ON THE RIGHT SIDE OF HIS HEAD, AS WELL AS HIS NECK. I PHOTOGRAPHED MR. BANCHERI'S INJURIES AND ATTACHED THEM TO THE CASE. MR. BANCHERI STATED THAT A BRICK AND ROCKS WERE ALSO THROWN AT HIM DURING THE INCIDENT. I ASKED MR. BANCHERI IF HE KNEW THE NAMES OF EITHER OF THE ACCUSED. MR. BANCHERI STATED THAT HE DID NOT. MR. BANCHERI STATED THAT HE BELIEVES THE FEMALE IS THE DAUGHTER OF HIS NEIGHBOR. MR. BANCHERI STATED THAT THE ACCUSED FEMALE WAS "PROBABLY IN HER 20'S". MR. BANCHERI COULD ONLY DESCRIBE THE MALE AS AN...

AFRICAN AMERICAN MALE WITH A RED HAT WITH DARKER CLOTHING. MR. BANCHERI STATED THAT THE ACCUSED MALE WAS IN HIS 20'S AS WELL.

MR. BANCHERI ALSO STATED THAT DURING THE INCIDENT HE DROPPED HIS KEYS TO HIS HOME AND VEHICLE, WHICH HAD A LEATHER CASE, AND HIS CELL PHONE. MR. BANCHERI STATED THAT HE WAS ABLE TO RECOVER HIS CELL PHONE, BUT WAS UNABLE TO RECOVER HIS KEYS. MR. BANCHERI STATED THAT HE NOW HAS TO GET HIS HOME, AS WELL AS HIS VEHICLE RE-KEYED. MR. BANCHERI STATED THAT HIS VEHICLE WAS SPIT ON AND THERE WAS A SMALL DENT ON THE TOP OF HIS VEHICLE. MR. BANCHERI STATED THAT THE ACCUSED FEMALE CAUSED THE DENT.

I EXPLAINED THE CITIZEN COMPLAINT PROCESS TO MR. BANCHERI. MR. BANCHERI SEEMED CONFUSED AND DID NOT UNDERSTAND THE PROCESS. SGT. HUENKE CAME INTO THE LOBBY AND SPOKE WITH MR. BANCHERI. SGT. HUENKE ATTEMPTED TO EXPLAIN THE CITIZEN COMPLAINT PROCESS TO MR. BANCHERI IN MORE SPECIFIC DETAIL. MR. BANCHERI STILL SEEMED CONFUSED, BUT STATED THAT HE UNDERSTOOD.

SGT. HUENKE AND I EXPLAINED TO MR. BANCHERI THAT AN INVESTIGATION NEEDED TO BE DONE TO ATTEMPT TO IDENTIFY THE ACCUSED PARTIES AND IT WOULD MOST LIKELY NOT BE COMPLETED IMMEDIATELY. MR. BANCHERI STATED THAT HE UNDERSTOOD. I ADVISED MR. BANCHERI THAT I WOULD CONTACT HIM WHEN MORE INFORMATION WAS GATHERED ON THE ACCUSED PARTIES.

I MADE CONTACT WITH PTL. IMBERTI IN REFERENCE TO THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION. PTL. IMBERTI STATED THAT HE WAS ONLY ABLE TO GATHER PARTIAL INFORMATION ABOUT THE ACCUSED PARTIES. PTL. IMBERTI STATED THAT HE WAS CURRENTLY AWAITING A CALLBACK TO OBTAIN MORE INFORMATION.
